- The pronouncement against **Egypt!** Look! Yehowah is riding on a swift cloud and coming into **Egypt**. And the valueless gods of **Egypt will** certainly quiver because of him, and the very heart of **Egypt will** melt in the midst of it. (**Isaiah 19:1**)
- Son of man, set your face against Pharaoh the king of **Egypt** and prophesy against him and against **Egypt** in its entirety. (**Ezekiel 29:2**)
- This is what Yehowah has said, The supporters of **Egypt must** also fall, and the pride of its strength **must come** down. From Migdol to Syene they **will** fall in it even by the sword, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 30:6**)
- And they **will** have to know that I am Yehowah when I set a fire in **Egypt** and all its helpers are actually broken. (**Ezekiel 30:8**)
- So the king of Assyria **will** lead the body of captives of **Egypt** and the exiles of **Ethiopia**, boys and old men, naked and barefoot, and with buttocks stripped, the nakedness of **Egypt**. (**Isaiah 20:4**)
- So my word that goes forth from my mouth **will** prove to be. It **will** not return to me without results, but it **will** certainly do that in which I have delighted, and it **will** have certain success in that for which I have sent it. (**Isaiah 55:11**)
- And when it **comes** true, **look!** It **must come** true, they **will** also have to know that a prophet himself had proved to be in the midst of them. (**Ezekiel 33:33**)
- It is the one sending forth envoys by means of the sea, and by means of vessels of papyrus upon the surface of the waters, saying; Go, **you** swift **messengers**, to a nation drawn out and scoured, to a people fear-inspiring everywhere, a nation of tensile strength and of treading down, whose land the rivers have washed away. (**Isaiah 18:2**)
