Ezekiel 31:3" Look! An Assyrian, a cedar in Lebanon, pretty in bough, with a woody thicket offering shadow, and high in stature, so that among the clouds its treetop proved to be.

- For this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; It was to Egypt that my people went down in the first instance to reside there as aliens, and without cause Assyria, for its part, oppressed them. (Isaiah 52:4)
- A young man I used to be, I have also grown old, and yet I have not seen anyone righteous left entirely, nor his offspring looking for bread. (Psalms 37:25)
- The mountains were covered with its shadow, and the cedars of God with its boughs. (Psalms 80:10)
- By means of your servants you have taunted Yehowah and you say; 'with the multitude of my war chariots I myself; I shall certainly ascend the height of mountainous regions, the remotest parts of Lebanon, and I shall cut down its lofty cedars, its choice juniper trees. And I shall enter its final height, the forest of its orchard. (Isaiah 37:24)
- And you must say; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; The great eagle, having great wings, with long pinions, full of plumage, which had color variety, came to Lebanon and proceeded to take the treetop of the cedar. (Ezekiel 17:3)
- Look! The true Lord, Yehowah of armies, is lopping off boughs with a terrible crash, and those tall in growth are being cut down, and the high ones themselves become low. (Isaiah 10:33)
- Now the visions of my head upon my bed I happened to be beholding, and, look! A tree in the midst of the earth, the height of which was immense. (Daniel 4:10)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; I myself will also take and put some of the lofty treetop of the cedar, from the

- top of its twigs I shall pluck off a tender one and I will myself transplant it upon a high and lofty mountain. (Ezekiel 17:22)
- At this the bramble said to the trees; If it is in truth that you are anointing me as king over you, come, seek refuge under my shadow. But if not, let fire come out of the bramble and consume the cedars of Lebanon. (Judges 9:15)
- And upon all the cedars of Lebanon that are lofty and lifted up and upon all the massive trees of Bashan. (Isaiah 2:13)
- Even therefore, look! Yehowah is bringing up against them the mighty and the many waters of the River, the king of Assyria and all his glory. And he will certainly come up over all his streambeds and go over all his banks (Isaiah 8:7)
- In order to break the Assyrian in my land and that I may tread him down on my own mountains, and that his yoke may actually depart from upon them and that his very load may depart from upon their shoulder. (Isaiah 14:25)
- And they came to be for her strong rods, meant for the scepters of rulers. And its height gradually became tall up among branches, and it got to be visible because of its tallness, because of the abundance of its foliage. (Ezekiel 19:11)
- The tree that you beheld, that grew great and became strong and the height of which finally reached the heavens and which was visible to all the earth. (Daniel 4:20)
- And he will stretch out his hand toward the north, and he will destroy Assyria. And he will make Nineveh a desolate waste, a waterless region like the wilderness. (Zephaniah 2:13)
- Howl, O juniper tree, for the cedar has fallen, because the majestic ones themselves have been despoiled! Howl, you massive trees of Bashan, for the impenetrable forest has come down! (Zechariah 11:2)
