- **Saying; We thank you, Yehowah God, the Almighty, the One who is and who was, because you **have** taken your great power and begun ruling as king. (**Revelation 11:17**)**
- **But the nations became wrathful, and your own wrath came, and the appointed time for the dead to be judged, and to give their reward to your slaves the prophets and to the holy ones and to those fearing your name, the small and the great, and to bring to ruin those ruining the earth. (**Revelation 11:18**)**
- **Let every soul be in subjection to the superior authorities, for there is no authority except by God, the existing authorities stand placed in their relative positions by God. (**Romans 13:1**)**
- **However, the inspired utterance says definitely that in later periods of time some **will** fall away from the faith, paying attention to misleading inspired utterances and teachings of demons. (**1 Timothy 4:1**)**
- **By the hypocrisy of men who speak lies, marked in their conscience as with a branding iron. (**1 Timothy 4:2**)**
- **Forbidding to marry, commanding to abstain from foods which God created to be partaken of with thanksgiving by those who **have** faith and accurately **know** the truth. (**1 Timothy 4:3**)**
- **The reason for this is that every creation of God is fine, and nothing is to be rejected if it is received with thanksgiving. (**1 Timothy 4:4**)**
- **For it is sanctified through God's word and prayer over it. (**1 Timothy 4:5**)**
- **Preach the word, be at it urgently in favorable season, in troublesome season, reprove, reprimand, exhort, with all long-suffering and art of teaching. (**2 Timothy 4:2**)**
- **For there **will** be a period of time when they **will** not put up with the healthful teaching, but, in accord with their own desires, they**

- will** accumulate teachers for themselves to **have** their ears tickled. (**2 Timothy 4:3**)
- And they **will** turn their ears away from the truth, whereas they **will** be turned aside to false stories. (**2 Timothy 4:4**)
 - Wronging themselves as a reward for wrongdoing. They consider luxurious living in the daytime a pleasure. They are spots and blemishes, indulging with unrestrained delight in their deceptive teachings while feasting together with **you**. (**2 Peter 2:13**)
 - Fruitful **land** into salt country, owing to the badness of those dwelling in it. (**Psalms 107:34**)
 - And I **will** make the **land** of **Egypt** a **desolate waste** in the midst of **desolated lands**, and its own cities **will** become a **desolate waste** in the very midst of devastated cities for forty years, and I **will** scatter the Egyptians among the nations and disperse them among the lands. (**Ezekiel 29:12**)
 - And the Egyptians **will** certainly **know** that I **am** Yehowah when I stretch out my hand against **Egypt**, and I shall indeed bring the sons of Israel out from their midst. (**Exodus 7:5**)
 - So I shall indeed let Pharaoh's heart become obstinate, and he **will** certainly chase after them and I shall get glory for myself by means of Pharaoh and all his military forces, and the Egyptians **will** certainly **know** that I **am** Yehowah. Accordingly they did just that. (**Exodus 14:4**)
 - Yehowah is known by the judgment that he has executed. By the activity of his own hands the wicked one has been ensnared. (**Psalms 9:16**)
 - And I **will** scatter the Egyptians among the nations and disperse them among the **lands**, and they **will have to know** that I **am** Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 30:26**)
 - Make for yourself mere baggage for exile, O inhabitress, the daughter of **Egypt**. For Noph itself **will** become a mere object of astonishment and **will** actually be set afire, so as to be without an inhabitant. (**Jeremiah 46:19**)
