[4] - References:

- Wake up, wake up, put on your strength, O Zion! Put on your beautiful garments, O Jerusalem, the holy city! For no more **will** there come again into you the **uncircumcised** and unclean one. (**Isaiah 52:1**)
- And now, what interest do I have here? Is the utterance of Yehowah. For my people were taken for nothing. The very **ones** ruling over them kept howling, is the utterance of Yehowah, and constantly, all day long, my name was being treated with disrespect. (**Isaiah 52:5**)
- How comely upon the mountains are the feet of the one bringing Good News, the one publishing peace, the one bringing Good News of something better, the one publishing salvation, the one saying to Zion; Your God has become king! (**Isaiah 52:7**)
- To whom shall I speak and give warning, that they may hear? Look! Their ear is **uncircumcised**, so that they are unable to pay attention. Look! The very word of Yehowah has become to them a reproach, in which word they can take no delight. (**Jeremiah 6:10**)
- Look! Days are coming, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I **will** hold an accounting with everyone circumcised but still in uncircumcision. (**Jeremiah 9:25**)
- Upon Egypt and upon Judah and upon Edom and upon the sons of Ammon and upon Moab and upon all those with hair clipped at the temples who are dwelling in the wilderness, for all the nations are **uncircumcised**, and all the house of Israel are **uncircumcised** in heart. (**Jeremiah 9:26**)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; No foreigner, **uncircumcised** in heart and **uncircumcised** in flesh, may come into my sanctuary, that is, any foreigner who is in the midst of the sons of Israel. (**Ezekiel 44:9**)
