Sovereign Lord Yehowah; I take delight, not in the death of the wicked one, but in that someone wicked turns back from his way and actually keeps living. Turn back, turn back from your bad ways, for why is it that you should die, O house of Israel?

[32] - References:

- For we shall die without fail and be like waters that are being poured down to the earth, which cannot be gathered. But God will not take away a soul, and he has thought out reasons why the one banished should not be banished from him. (2 Samuel 14:14)
- Do I take any delight at all in the death of someone wicked, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, and not in that he should turn back from his ways and actually keep living? (Ezekiel 18:23)
- Throw off from yourselves all Your transgressions in which You have transgressed and make for yourselves a new heart and a new spirit, for why should You die, O house of Israel? (Ezekiel 18:31)
- Thus, I tell you, joy arises among the angels of God over one sinner that repents. (Luke 15:10)
- Whose will is that all sorts of men should be saved and come to an accurate knowledge of truth. (1 Timothy 2:4)
- Return, you people, to the One against whom the sons of Israel have gone deep in their revolt. (Isaiah 31:6)
- Let Israel keep waiting for Yehowah. For there is lovingkindness with Yehowah, and abundantly so is there redemption with him. (Psalms 130:7)
- Turn back at my reproof. Then to YOU I will cause my spirit to bubble forth, I will make my words known to YOU. (Proverbs 1:23)
- Let the wicked man leave his way, and the harmful man his thoughts, and let him return to Yehowah, who will have mercy upon him, and to our God, for he will forgive in a large way. (Isaiah 55:7)

- Return, You renegade sons. I shall heal Your renegade condition. Here we are! We have come to you, for you, O Yehowah, are our God. (Jeremiah 3:22)
- They saying; Turn back, please, every one from his bad way and from the badness of YOUR dealings, and continue dwelling upon the ground that Yehowah gave to YOU and to YOUR forefathers from long ago and to a long time to come. (Jeremiah 25:5)
- Therefore say to the house of Israel; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Come back and turn yourselves back from YOUR dungy idols and turn YOUR faces back even from all YOUR detestable things. (Ezekiel 14:6)
- Do come back, O Israel, to Yehowah your God, for you have stumbled in your error. (Hosea 14:1)
- Repent, therefore, and turn around so as to get YOUR sins blotted out, that seasons of refreshing may come from the person of Yehowah (Acts of Apostles 3:19)
- Yehowah is not slow respecting his promise, as some people consider slowness, but he is patient with you because he does not desire any to be destroyed but desires all to attain to repentance. (2 Peter 3:9)
- And I, I stayed in the mountain the same as the first days, forty days and forty nights, and Yehowah proceeded to listen to me also on that occasion. Yehowah did not want to bring you to ruin. (Deuteronomy 10:10)
- For you will listen to the voice of Yehowah your God so as to keep his commandments and his statutes written in this book of the Law, because you will return to Yehowah your God with all your heart and all your soul. (Deuteronomy 30:10)
- Answer me, O Yehowah, answer me, that this people may know that you, Yehowah, are the true God and you yourself have turned their heart back. (1 Kings 18:37)
- Why is it that the wicked themselves keep living, have grown old, also have become superior in wealth? (Job 21:7)
- Where else will you be struck still more, in that you add more revolt? The whole head is in a sick condition, and the whole heart is feeble. (Isaiah 1:5)

- Search for Yehowah, You people, while he may be found. Call to him while he proves to be near. (Isaiah 55:6)
- Go, and you must proclaim these words to the north and say; Do return, O renegade Israel, is the utterance of Yehowah. I shall not have my face drop angrily upon you people, for I am loyal, is the utterance of Yehowah. I shall not stay resentful to time indefinite. (Jeremiah 3:12)
- And that nation actually turns back from its badness against which I spoke, I will also feel regret over the calamity that I had thought to execute upon it. (Jeremiah 18:8)
- Why should you yourself and your people die by the sword, by the famine and by the pestilence according to what Yehowah has spoken to the nation that does not serve the king of Babylon? (Jeremiah 27:13)
- Perhaps those of the house of Judah will listen to all the calamity that I am thinking of doing to them, to the end that they may return, each one from his bad way, and that I may actually forgive their error and their sin. (Jeremiah 36:3)
- For not out of his own heart has he afflicted or does he grieve the sons of men. (Lamentations 3:33)
- Do I take any delight at all in the death of someone wicked, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, and not in that he should turn back from his ways and actually keep living? (Ezekiel 18:23)
- For I do not take any delight in the death of someone dying, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. So cause a turning back and keep living, O you people. (Ezekiel 18:32)
- Search for Yehowah, and keep living, that he may not become operative just like fire, O house of Joseph, and it may not actually devour, and Bethel may not be with no one to extinguish it. (Amos 5:6)
- Hence he prayed to Yehowah and said; Ah, now, O Yehowah, was not this an affair of mine, while I happened to be on my own ground? That is why I went ahead and ran away to Tarshish, for I knew that you are a God gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abundant in loving-kindness, and feeling regret over the calamity. (Jonah 4:2)

- And you must say to them; This is what Yehowah of armies has said; Return to me, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies, and I shall return to you, Yehowah of armies has said. (Zechariah 1:3)
- He gave himself for our sins that he might deliver us from the present wicked system of things according to the will of our God and Father. (Galatians 1:4)
