Ezekiel 33:21... At length it occurred in the twelfth year, in the tenth month, on the fifth day of the month of our exile, that there came to me the escaped one from Jerusalem, saying; The city has been struck down!

- And your very tongue I will make stick to the roof of your mouth, and you will certainly become mute, and you will not become to them a man administering reproof, because they are a rebellious house. (Ezekiel 3:26)
- In that day there will come to you the escaped one for making the ears hear? (Ezekiel 24:26)
- In that day your mouth will be opened to the escaped one, and you will speak and be mute no longer, and you will certainly become to them a portent, and they will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 24:27)
- For the heart of this people has grown unreceptive, and with their ears they have heard without response, and they have shut their eyes, that they might never see with their eyes and hear with their ears and get the sense of it with their hearts and turn back, and I heal them. (Matthew 13:15)
- Woe to You, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! Because You shut up the kingdom of the heavens before men, for You yourselves do not go in, neither do You permit those on their way in to go in. (Matthew 23:13)
- These have the authority to shut up heaven that no rain should fall during the days of their prophesying, and they have authority over the waters to turn them into blood and to strike the earth with every sort of plague as often as they wish. (Revelation 11:6)
- In that day there will come to you the escaped one for making the ears hear? (Ezekiel 24:26)
- And the city got to be breached, and all the men of war fled by night by the way of the gate between the double wall that is by the king's garden, while the Chaldeans were all around against the city, and the king began to go in the direction of the Arabah. (2 Kings 25:4)

- So he brought up against them the king of the Chaldeans, who proceeded to kill their young men with the sword in the house of their sanctuary, neither did he feel compassion for young man or virgin, old or decrepit. Everything He gave into his hand. (2 Chronicles 36:17)
- In the eleventh year of Zedekiah, in the fourth month, on the ninth day of the month, the city was broken through. (Jeremiah 39:2)
- And it must occur that, in case they say to you; On account of what are you sighing? You must say; At a report. For it will certainly come, and every heart must melt and all hands must drop down and every spirit must become dejected and all knees themselves will drip with water. Look! It will certainly come and be brought to occur, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 21:7)
- In the twenty-fifth year of our exile, in the start of the year, on the tenth day of the month, in the fourteenth year after the city had been struck down, on this very same day the hand of Yehowah proved to be upon me, so that he brought me to that place. (Ezekiel 40:1)
