

Ezekiel 33:28 And I shall actually make the land a desolate waste, even desolation, and the pride of its strength must be made to cease and the mountains of Israel must be laid desolate, with no one passing through.

[13] - References:

- The garland **must** come to you, O inhabiter of the **land**, the time **must** come, the day is near. There is confusion, and not the shouting of the **mountains**. (**Ezekiel 7:7**)
- Now shortly I shall pour out my rage upon you, and I will bring my anger against you to its finish, and I will judge you according to your ways and bring upon you all your detestable things. (**Ezekiel 7:8**)
- Neither will my eye feel sorry nor shall I feel compassion. According to your ways shall I do the bringing upon you yourself, and your own detestable things will come to be right in the midst of you, and **you** people will have to know that I am Yehowah doing the smiting. (**Ezekiel 7:9**)
- Look! The day! Look! It is coming. The garland has gone forth. The rod has blossomed. Presumptuousness has sprouted. (**Ezekiel 7:10**)
- To fulfill Yehowah's word by the mouth of Jeremiah, until the **land** had paid off its Sabbaths. All the days of lying desolated it kept Sabbath, to fulfill seventy years. (**2 Chronicles 36:21**)
- At this I said; How long, O Yehowah? Then he said; Until the cities actually crash in ruins, to be without an inhabitant, and the houses be without earthling man, and the ground itself is ruined into a **desolation**. (**Isaiah 6:11**)
- And I will **make** Jerusalem piles of stones, the lair of jackals, and the cities of Judah I shall **make** a **desolate waste**, without an inhabitant. (**Jeremiah 9:11**)
- This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of **Israel**, has said; **You** yourselves have seen all the calamity that I have brought in upon Jerusalem and upon all the cities of Judah, and here they are a devastated place this day, and in them there is no inhabitant. (**Jeremiah 44:2**)

- And the desolated **land** itself will be cultivated, whereas it had become a **desolate waste** before the eyes of every passerby. (**Ezekiel 36:34**)
- And the **land must** become a **desolate waste** on account of its inhabitants, because of the fruit of their dealings. (**Micah 7:13**)
- Say to the house of **Israel**; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said, Here I am profaning my sanctuary, the **pride** of **YOUR strength**, the thing desirable to **YOUR** eyes and the object of **YOUR** soul's compassion, and **YOUR** sons and **YOUR** daughters whom **YOU** people have left behind, by the sword they will fall. (**Ezekiel 24:21**)
- And you **must** say, O **mountains** of **Israel**, hear the word of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said to the **mountains** and to the hills, to the streambeds and to the valleys; Here I am! I am bringing upon **YOU** a sword, and I shall certainly destroy **YOUR** high places. (**Ezekiel 6:3**)
- For this is what Yehowah has said; A **desolate waste** is what the whole **land** will become, and shall I not carry out a sheer extermination? (**Jeremiah 4:27**)
- Son of man, set your face toward the **mountains** of **Israel** and prophesy to them. (**Ezekiel 6:2**)
- And **you** will have to do just as I have done. Mustaches **you** will not cover over, and the bread of men **you** will not eat. (**Ezekiel 24:22**)
- The Sovereign Lord Yehowah has sworn by his own soul, is the utterance of Yehowah the God of armies, I am detesting the **pride** of Jacob, and his dwelling towers I have hated, and I will deliver up the city and what fills it. (**Amos 6:8**)
