Ezekiel 33:28... And I shall actually make the land a desolate waste, even desolation, and the pride of its strength must be made to cease and the mountains of Israel must be laid desolate, with no one passing through.

[13] - References:

- The garland must come to you, O inhabiter of the land, the time must come, the day is near. There is confusion, and not the shouting of the mountains. (Ezekiel 7:7)
- Now shortly I shall pour out my rage upon you, and I will bring my anger against you to its finish, and I will judge you according to your ways and bring upon you all your detestable things. (Ezekiel 7:8)
- Neither will my eye feel sorry nor shall I feel compassion.
 According to your ways shall I do the bringing upon you yourself, and your own detestable things will come to be right in the midst of you, and you people will have to know that I am Yehowah doing the smiting. (Ezekiel 7:9)
- Look! The day! Look! It is coming. The garland has gone forth. The rod has blossomed. Presumptuousness has sprouted. (Ezekiel 7:10)
- To fulfill Yehowah's word by the mouth of Jeremiah, until the land had paid off its Sabbaths. All the days of lying desolated it kept Sabbath, to fulfill seventy years. (2 Chronicles 36:21)
- At this I said; How long, O Yehowah? Then he said; Until the cities actually crash in ruins, to be without an inhabitant, and the houses be without earthling man, and the ground itself is ruined into a desolation. (Isaiah 6:11)
- And I will make Jerusalem piles of stones, the lair of jackals, and the cities of Judah I shall make a desolate waste, without an inhabitant. (Jeremiah 9:11)
- This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; You yourselves have seen all the calamity that I have brought in upon Jerusalem and upon all the cities of Judah, and here they are a devastated place this day, and in them there is no inhabitant. (Jeremiah 44:2)

- And the desolated land itself will be cultivated, whereas it had become a desolate waste before the eyes of every passerby. (Ezekiel 36:34)
- And the land must become a desolate waste on account of its inhabitants, because of the fruit of their dealings. (Micah 7:13)
- Yehowah has said, Here I am profaning my sanctuary, the pride of Your strength, the thing desirable to Your eyes and the object of Your soul's compassion, and Your sons and Your daughters whom You people have left behind, by the sword they will fall. (Ezekiel 24:21)
- And you must say, O mountains of Israel, hear the word of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said to the mountains and to the hills, to the streambeds and to the valleys; Here I am! I am bringing upon you a sword, and I shall certainly destroy your high places. (Ezekiel 6:3)
- For this is what Yehowah has said; A desolate waste is what the whole land will become, and shall I not carry out a sheer extermination? (Jeremiah 4:27)
- Son of man, set your face toward the mountains of Israel and prophesy to them. (Ezekiel 6:2)
- And you will have to do just as I have done. Mustaches you will not cover over, and the bread of men you will not eat. (Ezekiel 24:22)
- The Sovereign Lord Yehowah has sworn by his own soul, is the utterance of Yehowah the God of armies, I am detesting the pride of Jacob, and his dwelling towers I have hated, and I will deliver up the city and what fills it. (Amos 6:8)
