Ezekiel 33:30... And as for you, O Son of Man, the sons of your people are speaking with one another about you beside the walls and in the entrances of the houses, and the one has spoken with the other, each one with his brother, saying, COME, please, and hear what the word is that is going forth from Yehowah.

- Therefore the Jews began looking for him at the festival and saying; Where is that man? (John 7:11)
- And there was a lot of subdued talk about him among the crowds. Some would say; He is a good man. Others would say; He is not, but he misleads the crowd. (John 7:12)
- No one, of course, would speak about him publicly because of the fear of the Jews. (John 7:13)

- This people honors me with their lips, yet their heart is far removed from me. (Matthew 15:8)
- The word that occurred to Jeremiah from Yehowah, when King Zedekiah sent to him Pashhur the son of Malchiah and Zephaniah the son of Maaseiah, the priest, saying; (Jeremiah 21:1)
