Ezekiel 33:31... And they will come in to you, like the coming in of people, and sit before you as my people, and they will certainly hear your words but these they will not do, for with their mouth they are expressing lustful desires and after their unjust gain is where their heart is going.

- Therefore they began to say to him; Who are you? Jesus said to them; Why am I even speaking to you at all? (John 8:25)
- I have many things to speak concerning You and to pass judgment upon. As a matter of fact, he that sent me is true, and the very things I heard from him I am speaking in the world. (John 8:26)
- They did not grasp that he was talking to them about the Father. (John 8:27)
- Therefore Jesus said; When once you have lifted up the Son of man, then you will know that I am he, and that I do nothing of my own initiative, but just as the Father taught me I speak these things. (John 8:28)
- Why is it you do not know what I am speaking? Because you cannot listen to my word. (John 8:43)
- You are from Your father the Devil, and You wish to do the desires of Your father. That one was a manslayer when he began, and he did not stand fast in the truth, because truth is not in him. When he speaks the lie, he speaks according to his own disposition, because he is a liar and the father of the lie. (John 8:44)
- Because I, on the other hand, tell the truth, you do not believe me. (John 8:45)
- And it came about in the sixth year, in the sixth month, on the fifth day of the month, that I was sitting in my house and the older men of Judah were sitting before me, when the hand of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah fell upon me there. (Ezekiel 8:1)
- Now it came about in the seventh year, in the fifth month, on the tenth day of the month, that men from the elderly ones of Israel came in to inquire of Yehowah, and they proceeded to sit down before me. (Ezekiel 20:1)

- And Yehowah says; For the reason that this people have come near with their mouth, and they have glorified me merely with their lips, and they have removed their heart itself far away from me, and their fear toward me becomes men's commandment that is being taught. (Isaiah 29:13)
- This is what Yehowah has said; Stand still in the ways, YOU people, and see, and ask for the roadways of long ago, where, now, the good way is, and walk in it, and find ease for YOUR souls. But they kept saying; We are not going to walk. (Jeremiah 6:16)
- But we shall positively do every word that has gone forth from our mouth, in order to make sacrificial smoke to the queen of the heavens and to pour out to her drink offerings, just as we ourselves and our forefathers, our kings and our princes did in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem, when we used to be satisfied with bread and to be well off, and we did not see any calamity at all. (Jeremiah 44:17)
- Not everyone saying to me; Lord, Lord, will enter into the kingdom of the heavens, but the one doing the will of my Father who is in the heavens will. (Matthew 7:21)
- On the other hand, he who hears and does not do, is like a man who built a house upon the ground without a foundation.

  Against it the river dashed, and immediately it collapsed, and the ruin of that house became great. (Luke 6:49)
- No one can slave for two masters, for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will stick to the one and despise the other. You cannot slave for God and for Riches. (Matthew 6:24)
- However, the people refused to listen to the voice of Samuel and said; No, but a king is what will come to be over us. (1 Samuel 8:19)
- And they tried to fool him with their mouth, and with their tongue they tried to lie to him. (Psalms 78:36)
- For from the least one of them even to the greatest one of them, every one is making for himself unjust gain, and from the prophet even to the priest, each one is acting falsely. (Jeremiah 6:13)
- Therefore I shall give their wives to other men, their fields to those taking possession, for, from the least one even to the

- greatest one, each one is making unjust gain, from the prophet even to the priest, each one is acting falsely. (Jeremiah 8:10)
- And men from the elderly ones of Israel proceeded to come to me and sit down before me. (Ezekiel 14:1)
- For any man at all from the house of Israel or from the alien residents that reside as aliens in Israel, that withdraws himself from following me and that brings up his dungy idols upon his heart and that sets the very stumbling block causing his error in front of his face and that actually comes to the prophet to make inquiry for himself by me, I, Yehowah, I am letting myself be brought to answer him by myself. (Ezekiel 14:7)
- As for the one sown upon the rocky places, this is the one hearing the word and at once accepting it with joy. (Matthew 13:20)
- It is in vain that they keep worshiping me, because they teach commands of men as doctrines. (Matthew 15:9)
- He said to them; Isaiah aptly prophesied about You hypocrites, as it is written: This people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far removed from me. (Mark 7:6)
