But as regards you, in case you actually warn someone wicked from his way for him to turn back from it but he actually does not turn back from his way, he himself will die in his own error, whereas you yourself will certainly deliver your own soul.¹

[5] - References:

- Discipline is bad to the one leaving the path, anyone hating reproof **will die**. (**Proverbs 15:10**)
- But as for you, in **case** you have warned **someone wicked** and he does not **actually turn back** from his wickedness and from his **wicked way**, he himself for his **error will die**, but as for you, you **will** have delivered your **own soul**. (**Ezekiel 3:19**)
- But after they kept on opposing and speaking abusively, he shook out his garments and said to them; Let **YOUR** blood be upon **YOUR own** heads. I am clean. From now on I **will** go to people of the nations. (**Acts of Apostles 18:6**)
- So he said; I **certainly** see all the Israelites scattered on the mountains, like sheep that have no shepherd. And Yehowah went on to say; These have no masters. Let them go **back** each one to his house in peace. (**1 Kings 22:17**)
- Look! The righteous one, in the earth he **will** be rewarded. How much more should the **wicked** one and the sinner be! (**Proverbs 11:31**)
