Ezekiel 34:10... This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am against the shepherds, and I shall certainly ask back my sheep from their hand and make them cease from feeding my sheep, and the shepherds will no longer feed themselves, and I will deliver my sheep out of their mouth, and they will not become food for them.

- And all the nations will be gathered before him, and he will separate people one from another, just as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats. (Matthew 25:32)
- And he will put the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on his left. (Matthew 25:33)

- Then he will say, in turn, to those on his left; Be on YOUR way from me, YOU who have been cursed, into the everlasting fire prepared for the Devil and his angels. (Matthew 25:41)
- For I became hungry, but you gave me nothing to eat, and I got thirsty, but you gave me nothing to drink. (Matthew 25:42)
- I was a stranger, but you did not receive me hospitably, naked, but you did not clothe me, sick and in prison, but you did not look after me. (Matthew 25:43)
- Then they also will answer with the words; Lord, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison and did not minister to you? (Matthew 25:44)
- Then he will answer them with the words; Truly I say to You, to the extent that You did not do it to one of these least ones, You did not do it to me. (Matthew 25:45)
- And these will depart into everlasting cutting-off, but the righteous ones into everlasting life. (Matthew 25:46)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; For the reason that you men have spoken untruth and you have visioned a lie, therefore here I am against you, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 13:8)
- Against the shepherds my anger has grown hot, and against the goatlike leaders I shall hold an accounting, for Yehowah of armies has turned his attention to his drove, the house of Judah, and has made them like his horse of dignity in the battle. (Zechariah 10:3)
- Why do you men keep kicking at my sacrifice and at my offering that I have commanded in my dwelling, and you keep honoring your sons more than me by fattening yourselves from the best of every offering of Israel my people? (1 Samuel 2:29)
- For he will deliver the poor one crying for help, also the afflicted one and whoever has no helper. (Psalms 72:12)
- Therefore untruth you women will not keep on visioning, and divination you will divine no longer, and I will deliver my people out of your hand, and you will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 13:23)

- Listen! The howling of shepherds, for their majesty has been despoiled. Listen! The roaring of maned young lions, for the proud thickets along the Jordan have been despoiled. (Zechariah 11:3)
