

Ezekiel 34:14 In a good pasturage I shall feed them, and on Israel's high mountains their abiding place will come to be. There they will lie down in a good abiding place, and on a fat pasturage they will feed upon the mountains of Israel.

- Hey there, all **you** thirsty ones! Come to the water. And the ones that have no money! Come, buy and eat. Yes, **come**, buy wine and milk even without money and without price. (**Isaiah 55:1**)
- Why do **you** people keep paying out money for what is not bread, and why is **your** toil for what results in no satisfaction? Listen intently to me, and eat what is **good**, and let **your** soul find its exquisite delight in fatness itself. (**Isaiah 55:2**)
- Incline **your** ear and **come** to me. Listen, and **your** soul **will** keep alive, and I shall readily conclude with **you** people an indefinitely lasting covenant respecting the loving-kindnesses to David that are faithful. (**Isaiah 55:3**)
- Look! As a witness to the national groups I have given him, as a leader and commander to the national groups. (**Isaiah 55:4**)
- Look! A nation that you do not know you **will** call, and those of a nation who have not known you **will** run even to you, for the sake of Yehowah your God, and for the Holy One of **Israel**, because he **will** have beautified you. (**Isaiah 55:5**)
- Listen to me, O **you** islands, and pay attention, **you** national groups far away. Yehowah himself has called me even from the belly. From the inward parts of my mother he has made mention of my name. (**Isaiah 49:1**)
- And he proceeded to make my mouth like a sharp sword. In the shadow of his hand he has hidden me. And he gradually made me a polished arrow. He concealed me in his own quiver. (**Isaiah 49:2**)
- And he went on to say to me; You are my servant, O **Israel**, you the one in whom I shall show my beauty. (**Isaiah 49:3**)
- In grassy pastures he makes me **lie down**, by well-watered resting-places he conducts me. (**Psalms 23:2**)

- And Yehowah of armies **will** certainly make for all the peoples, in this mountain, a banquet of well-oiled dishes, a banquet of wine kept on the dregs, of well-oiled dishes filled with marrow, of wine kept on the dregs, filtered. (**Isaiah 25:6**)
- And he **will** certainly give the rain for your seed with which you sow the ground, and as the produce of the ground bread, which must become **fat** and oily. Your livestock **will** graze in that day in a spacious pasture. (**Isaiah 30:23**)
- And they **will** certainly **come** and cry out joyfully on the height of Zion and become radiant over the goodness of Yehowah, over the grain and over the new wine and over the oil and over the young ones of the flock and the cattle. And their soul **will** simply become like a well-watered garden, and no more **will** they languish again. (**Jeremiah 31:12**)
- This is what Yehowah of armies has said; In this waste **place** without man and even domestic animal and in all its cities there **will** yet **come** to be the pasture ground of the shepherds who are making the flock **lie down**. (**Jeremiah 33:12**)
- And I myself shall collect together the remnant of my sheep out of all the lands to which I had dispersed them, and I **will** bring them back to their pasture ground, and they **will** certainly be fruitful and become many. (**Jeremiah 23:3**)
- And I **will** bring **Israel** back to his pasture ground, and he **will** certainly graze on Carmel and on Bashan, and in the mountainous region of Ephraim and of Gilead his soul **will** be satisfied. (**Jeremiah 50:19**)
