Ezekiel 34:20... Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said to them; Here I am, I myself, and I shall certainly judge between a plump sheep<sup>1</sup> and a lean sheep.

- The scribes and the Pharisees have seated themselves in the seat of Moses. (Matthew 23:2)
- Therefore all the things they tell you, do and observe, but do not do according to their deeds, for they say but do not perform.
