[3] - References:

- The scribes and the Pharisees have seated themselves in the seat of Moses. (**Matthew 23:2**)
- Therefore all the things they tell **you**, do and observe, but do not do according to their deeds, for they say but do not perform. (**Matthew 23:3**)
- They bind up heavy loads and put them upon the shoulders of men, but they themselves are not willing to budge them with their finger. (**Matthew 23:4**)
- All the works they do they do to be viewed by men, for they broaden the scripture-containing cases that they wear as safeguards, and enlarge the fringes of their garments. (**Matthew 23:5**)
- They like the most prominent place at evening meals and the front seats in the synagogues. (**Matthew 23:6**)
- And the greetings in the marketplaces and to be called Rabbi by men. (**Matthew 23:7**)
- But **you**, do not **you** be called Rabbi, for one is **your** teacher, whereas all **you** are brothers. (**Matthew 23:8**)
- Moreover, do not call anyone **your** father on earth, for one is **your** Father, the heavenly One. (**Matthew 23:9**)
- And I will clean out from **you** the revolters and the transgressors against me, for out of the land of their alien residence I shall bring them forth, but onto the soil of Israel they will not come, and **you** people will have to know that I **am** Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 20:38**)
- The fat is what **you** eat, and with the wool **you** clothe your own selves. The **plump** animal is what **you** slaughter. The flock itself **you** do not feed. (**Ezekiel 34:3**)
