Ezekiel 34:24" And I myself, Yehowah, will become their God, and my servant David a chieftain in the midst of them. I myself, Yehowah, have spoken.

- With that I heard a loud voice from the throne say; Look! The tent of God is with mankind, and he will reside with them, and they will be his peoples. And God himself will be with them. (Revelation 21:3)
- And he will wipe out every tear from their eyes, and death will be no more, neither will mourning nor outcry nor pain be anymore. The former things have passed away. (Revelation 21:4)
- While he was sitting upon the Mount of Olives, the disciples approached him privately, saying; Tell us, when will these things be, and what will be the sign of your presence and of the conclusion of the system of things? (Matthew 24:3)
- For nation will rise against nation and kingdom against kingdom, and there will be food shortages and earthquakes in one place after another. (Matthew 24:7)
- And this Good News of the kingdom will be preached in all the inhabited earth for a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come. (Matthew 24:14)
- Therefore, when you catch sight of the disgusting thing that causes desolation, as spoken of through Daniel the prophet, standing in a holy place, let the reader use discernment. (Matthew 24:15)
- Now learn from the fig tree as an illustration this point; Just as soon as its young branch grows tender and it puts forth leaves, you know that summer is near. (Matthew 24:32)
- Likewise also you, when you see all these things, know that he is near at the doors. (Matthew 24:33)

- Truly I say to you that this generation will by no means pass away until all these things occur. (Matthew 24:34)
- Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will by no means pass away. (Matthew 24:35)
- Concerning that day and hour nobody knows, neither the angels of the heavens nor the Son, but only the Father. (Matthew 24:36)
- For just as the days of Noah were, so the presence of the Son of man will be. (Matthew 24:37)
- For as they were in those days before the flood, eating and drinking, men marrying and women being given in marriage, until the day that Noah entered into the ark. (Matthew 24:38)
- And they took no note until the flood came and swept them all away, so the presence of the Son of man will be. (Matthew 24:39)
- Then two men will be in the field, one will be taken along and the other be abandoned. (Matthew 24:40)
- Two women will be grinding at the hand mill, one will be taken along and the other be abandoned. (Matthew 24:41)
- Keep on the watch, therefore, because you do not know on what day your Lord is coming. (Matthew 24:42)
- But know one thing, that if the householder had known in what watch the thief was coming, he would have kept awake and not allowed his house to be broken into. (Matthew 24:43)
- On this account you too prove yourselves ready, because at an hour that you do not think to be it, the Son of man is coming. (Matthew 24:44)
- Also, there will be signs in sun and moon and stars, and on the earth anguish of nations, not knowing the way out because of the roaring of the sea and its agitation. (Luke 21:25)
- While men become faint out of fear and expectation of the things coming upon the inhabited earth, for the powers of the heavens will be shaken. (Luke 21:26)

- And then they will see the Son of man coming in a cloud with power and great glory. (Luke 21:27)
- But as these things start to occur, raise yourselves erect and lift your heads up, because your deliverance is getting near. (Luke 21:28)
- And all your sons will be persons taught by Yehowah, and the peace of your sons will be abundant. (Isaiah 54:13)
- For there has been a child born to us, there has been a son given to us, and the princely rule will come to be upon his shoulder.

 And his name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. (Isaiah 9:6)
- To the abundance of the princely rule and to peace there will be no end, upon the throne of David and upon his kingdom in order to establish it firmly and to sustain it by means of justice and by means of righteousness, from now on and to time indefinite. The very zeal of Yehowah of armies will do this. (Isaiah 9:7)
- As for the crowds, those going ahead of him and those following kept crying out; Save, we pray, the Son of David! Blessed is he that comes in Yehowah's name! Save him, we pray, in the heights above! (Matthew 21:9)
- I have concluded a covenant toward my chosen one, I have sworn to David my servant. (Psalms 89:3)
- Even to time indefinite I shall firmly establish your seed, and I will build your throne to generation after generation. (Psalms 89:4)
- Consequently we have the prophetic word made more sure, and you are doing well in paying attention to it as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until day dawns and a daystar rises, in your hearts. (2 Peter 1:19)
- And I will carry out my covenant between me and you and your seed after you according to their generations for a covenant to time indefinite, to prove myself God to you and to your seed after you. (Genesis 17:7)
- And I will tabernacle in the midst of the sons of Israel, and I will prove to be their God. (Exodus 29:45)

- At that time, is the utterance of Yehowah, I shall become God to all the families of Israel, and as for them, they will become my people. (Jeremiah 31:1)
- And I shall certainly bring the third part through the fire, and I shall actually refine them as in the refining of silver, and examine them as in the examining of gold. It, for its part, will call upon my name, and I, for my part, will answer it. I will say, It is my people, and it, in its turn, will say, Yehowah is my God. (Zechariah 13:9)
- Saying; I, even I, have installed my king upon Zion, my holy mountain. (Psalms 2:6)
- For there has been a child born to us, there has been a son given to us. The princely rule will come to be upon his shoulder. His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. (Isaiah 9:6)

- And they will actually dwell upon the land that I gave to my servant, to Jacob, in which your forefathers dwelt, and they will actually dwell upon it, they and their sons and their sons' sons to time indefinite, and David my servant will be their chieftain to time indefinite. (Ezekiel 37:25)
- And during that time Michael will stand up, the great prince who is standing in behalf of the sons of your people. And there will certainly occur a time of distress such as has not been made to

- occur since there came to be a nation until that time. And during that time your people will escape, every one who is found written down in the book. (Daniel 12:1)
