

Ezekiel 34:26 And I will make them and the surroundings of my hill a blessing, and I will cause the pouring rain to descend in its time. Pouring rains of blessing there will prove to be.

- And he gradually brought me forth by the way of the north gate and took me around by the way outside to the outer gate that is facing toward the east, and, look! Water was trickling from the right-hand side. (**Ezekiel 47:2**)
- When the man went forth eastward with a measuring line in his hand, he also proceeded to measure a thousand in cubits and to **make** me pass through the water, water up to the ankles. (**Ezekiel 47:3**)
- And he continued measuring a thousand and then made me pass through the water, water up to the knees. And he continued measuring a thousand and now made me pass through, water up to the hips. (**Ezekiel 47:4**)
- And he continued measuring a thousand. It was a torrent that I was not able to pass through, for the water had got high, water permitting swimming, a torrent that could not be passed through. (**Ezekiel 47:5**)
- At that he said to me; Have you seen this, O son of man? Then he had me walk and had me return to the bank of the torrent. (**Ezekiel 47:6**)
- When I returned, why, look! On the bank of the torrent there were very many trees, on this side and on that side. (**Ezekiel 47:7**)
- And he went on to say to me; This water is going forth to the eastern region and must go down through the Arabah. And it must come to the sea. It being brought forth into the sea itself, its water is also actually healed. (**Ezekiel 47:8**)
- And it must occur that every living soul that swarms, in every place to which the double-size torrent comes, **will** get life. And it must occur that there **will** be very many fish, because there is where this water **will** certainly come, and the seawater **will** be healed, and everything **will** be alive where the torrent comes. (**Ezekiel 47:9**)

- And it must occur that fishers **will** actually stand alongside it from En-gedi even up to En-eglaim. There **will** come to be a drying yard for dragnets. In their kinds their fish **will prove** to be, like the fish of the Great Sea, very many. (**Ezekiel 47:10**)
- And he showed me a river of water of life, clear as crystal, flowing out from the throne of God and of the Lamb. (**Revelation 22:1**)
- Down the middle of its broad way. And on this side of the river and on that side there were trees of life producing twelve crops of fruit, yielding their fruits each month. And the leaves of the trees were for the curing of the nations. (**Revelation 22:2**)
- And no more **will** there be any curse. But the throne of God and of the Lamb **will** be in the city, and his slaves **will** render him sacred service. (**Revelation 22:3**)
- And they **will** see his face, and his name **will** be on their foreheads. (**Revelation 22:4**)
- Also, night **will** be no more, and they have no need of lamplight nor do they have sunlight, because Yehowah God **will** shed light upon them, and they **will** rule as kings forever and ever. (**Revelation 22:5**)
- I **will** also bring them to my holy mountain and **make** them rejoice inside my house of prayer. Their whole burnt offerings and their sacrifices **will** be for acceptance upon my altar. For my own house **will** be called even a house of prayer for all the peoples. (**Isaiah 56:7**)
- For in my holy mountain, in the mountain of the height of Israel, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, there is where they, the whole house of Israel in its entirety, **will** serve me, in the land. There I shall take pleasure in them, and there I shall require **YOUR** contributions and the firstfruits of **YOUR** presentations in all **YOUR** holy things. (**Ezekiel 20:40**)
- And it must occur in the final part of the days that the mountain of the house of Yehowah **will** become firmly established above the top of the mountains, and it **will** certainly be lifted up above the **hills**, and to it peoples must stream. (**Micah 4:1**)

- And I shall **make** a great nation out of you and I shall bless you and I **will make** your name great, and **prove** yourself a **blessing**. (**Genesis 12:2**)
- I shall also certainly give **YOUR** showers of **rain** at their proper time, and the land **will** indeed give its yield, and the tree of the field **will** give its fruit. (**Leviticus 26:4**)
- Yehowah **will** open up to you his good storehouse, the heavens, to give the **rain** on your land in its season and to bless every deed of your hand, and you **will** certainly lend to many nations, while you yourself **will** not borrow. (**Deuteronomy 28:12**)
- A copious downpour you began causing to fall, O God, your inheritance, even when it was weary, you yourself reinvigorated it. (**Psalms 68:9**)
- The **blessing** of Yehowah, that is what **makes** rich, and he adds no pain with it. (**Proverbs 10:22**)
- And it must occur that just as **YOU** became a malediction among the nations, O house of Judah and house of Israel, so I shall save **you**, and **you** must become a **blessing**. Do not be afraid. May **YOUR** hands be strong. (**Zechariah 8:13**)
- Bring all the tenth parts into the storehouse, that there may come to be food in my house, and test me out, please, in this respect, Yehowah of armies has said, whether I shall not open to **you** people the floodgates of the heavens and actually empty out upon **you** a **blessing** until there is no more want. (**Malachi 3:10**)
- He **will descend** like the **rain** upon the mown grass, like copious showers that wet the earth. (**Psalms 72:6**)
- In that day Israel **will** come to be the third with Egypt and with Assyria, namely, a **blessing** in the midst of the earth. (**Isaiah 19:24**)
- O **you** heavens, cause a dripping from above, and let the cloudy skies themselves trickle with righteousness. Let the earth open up, and let it be fruitful with salvation, and let it cause righteousness itself to spring up at the same time. I myself, Yehowah, have created it. (**Isaiah 45:8**)
- Make **YOUR** requests of Yehowah for **rain** in the time of the spring **rain**, even of Yehowah who is making the storm clouds, and who

gives a downpour of rain to them, to each one vegetation in the field. (Zechariah 10:1)
