

Ezekiel 35:3

And you must say to it; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am against you, O mountainous region of Seir, and I will stretch out my hand against you and make you a desolate waste, even a desolation.

[10] - References:

- And the sons within her began to struggle with each other, so that she **said**; If this is the way it is, just why **am** I alive? With that she went to inquire of Yehowah. (**Genesis 25:22**)
- And Yehowah proceeded to **say** to her; Two nations are in your belly, and two national groups **will** be separated from your inward parts, and the one national group **will** be stronger than the other national group, and the older **will** serve the younger. (**Genesis 25:23**)
- After these things the word of Yehowah came to Abram in a vision, saying; Do not fear, Abram. I **am** a shield for you. Your reward **will** be very great. (**Genesis 15:1**)
- At this Abram **said**; Sovereign **Lord** Yehowah, **what will** you give me, seeing that I **am** going childless and the one who **will** possess my house is a man of Damascus, Eliezer? (**Genesis 15:2**)
- And Abram added; Look! You have given me no seed, and, look! A son of my household is succeeding me as heir. (**Genesis 15:3**)
- But, look! the word of Yehowah to him was in these words; This man **will** not succeed you as heir, but one who **will** come **out** of your own inward parts **will** succeed you as heir. (**Genesis 15:4**)
- He now brought him outside and **said**; Look up, please, to the heavens and count the stars, if you are possibly able to count them. And he went on to **say** to him; So your seed **will** become. (**Genesis 15:5**)
- And he put faith in Yehowah, and he proceeded to count it to him as righteousness. (**Genesis 15:6**)
- Then he added to him; I **am** Yehowah, who brought you **out** of Ur of the Chaldeans to give you this land to take it in possession. (**Genesis 15:7**)

- To this he **said**; Sovereign **Lord** Yehowah, by **what** shall I know that I shall take it in possession? (**Genesis 15:8**)
- In turn he **said** to him; Take for me a three year old heifer and a three year old shegoat and a three year old ram and a turtledove and a young pigeon. (**Genesis 15:9**)
- So he took all these to himself and cut them in two and put each part of them so as to match the other, but the birds he did not cut in pieces. (**Genesis 15:10**)
- And the birds of prey began to descend upon the carcasses, but Abram kept driving them away. (**Genesis 15:11**)
- After a while the sun was about to set, and a deep sleep fell upon Abram, and, look! A frightfully great darkness was falling upon him. (**Genesis 15:12**)
- And he began to **say** to Abram; You may know for sure that your seed **will** become an alien resident in a land not theirs, and they **will** have to serve them, and these **will** certainly afflict them for four hundred years. (**Genesis 15:13**)
- But the nation that they **will** serve I **am** judging, and after that they **will** go **out** with many goods. (**Genesis 15:14**)
- As for you, you **will** go to your forefathers in peace, you **will** be buried at a good old age. (**Genesis 15:15**)
- But in the fourth generation they **will** return here, because the error of the Amorites **has** not yet come to completion. (**Genesis 15:16**)
- The sun was now setting and a dense darkness came and, look! A smoking furnace and a fiery torch that passed in between these pieces. (**Genesis 15:17**)
- On that day Yehowah concluded with Abram a covenant, saying; To your seed I **will** give this land, from the river of Egypt to the great river, the river Euphrates. (**Genesis 15:18**)
- The Kenites and the Kenizzites and the Kadmonites. (**Genesis 15:19**)
- And the Hittites and the Perizzites and the Rephaim. (**Genesis 15:20**)

- And the Amorites and the Canaanites and the Girgashites and the Jebusites. (**Genesis 15:21**)
- And God proceeded to speak all these words, saying; (**Exodus 20:1**)
- I **am** Yehowah your God, who have brought you **out** of the land of Egypt, **out** of the house of slaves. (**Exodus 20:2**)
- You must not have any other gods **against** my face. (**Exodus 20:3**)
- You must not **make** for yourself a carved image or a form like anything that is in the heavens above or that is on the earth underneath or that is in the waters under the earth. (**Exodus 20:4**)
- You must not bow down to them nor be induced to serve them, because I Yehowah your God **am** a God exacting exclusive devotion, bringing punishment for the error of fathers upon sons, upon the third generation and upon the fourth generation, in the case of those who hate me. (**Exodus 20:5**)
- But exercising loving-kindness toward the thousandth generation in the case of those who love me and keep my commandments. (**Exodus 20:6**)
- You must not take up the name of Yehowah your God in a worthless way, for Yehowah **will** not leave the one unpunished who takes up his name in a worthless way. (**Exodus 20:7**)
- Remembering the Sabbath day to hold it sacred. (**Exodus 20:8**)
- You are to render service and you must do all your work six days. (**Exodus 20:9**)
- But the seventh day is a Sabbath to Yehowah your God. You must not do any work, you nor your son nor your daughter, your slave man nor your slave girl nor your domestic animal nor your alien resident who is inside your gates. (**Exodus 20:10**)
- For in six days Yehowah made the heavens and the earth, the sea and everything that is in them, and he proceeded to rest on the seventh day. That is why Yehowah blessed the Sabbath day and proceeded to **make** it sacred. (**Exodus 20:11**)

- Honor your father and your mother in order that your days may prove long upon the ground that Yehowah your God is giving you. (**Exodus 20:12**)
- You must not murder. (**Exodus 20:13**)
- You must not commit adultery. (**Exodus 20:14**)
- You must not steal. (**Exodus 20:15**)
- You must not testify falsely as a witness **against** your fellowman. (**Exodus 20:16**)
- You must not desire your fellowman's house. You must not desire your fellowman's wife, nor his slave man nor his slave girl nor his bull nor his ass nor anything that belongs to your fellowman. (**Exodus 20:17**)
- When Abram got to be ninety-nine years old, then Yehowah appeared to Abram and **said** to him; **I am** God Almighty. Walk before me and prove yourself faultless. (**Genesis 17:1**)
- And I **will** give my covenant between me and you, that I may multiply you very, very much. (**Genesis 17:2**)
- At this Abram fell upon his face, and God continued to speak with him, saying; (**Genesis 17:3**)
- As for me, look! My covenant is with you, and you **will** certainly become a father of a crowd of nations. (**Genesis 17:4**)
- And your name **will** not be called Abram anymore, and your name must become Abraham, because a father of a crowd of nations I **will make** you. (**Genesis 17:5**)
- And I **will make** you very, very fruitful and **will make** you become nations, and kings **will** come **out** of you. (**Genesis 17:6**)
- And I **will** carry **out** my covenant between me and you and your seed after you according to their generations for a covenant to time indefinite, to prove myself God to you and to your seed after you. (**Genesis 17:7**)
- And I **will** give to you and to your seed after you the land of your alien residences, **even** the entire land of Canaan, for a possession

- to time indefinite, and I **will** prove myself God to them. (**Genesis 17:8**)
- And God **said** further to Abraham; As for you, you are to keep my covenant, you and your seed after you according to their generations. (**Genesis 17:9**)
 - This is my covenant that **you** men **will** keep, between me and **you** men, **even** your seed after you. Every male of **YOURS** must get circumcised. (**Genesis 17:10**)
 - And **you** must get circumcised in the flesh of **YOUR** foreskins, and it must serve as a sign of the covenant between me and **you**. (**Genesis 17:11**)
 - And every male of **YOURS** eight days old must be circumcised, according to your generations, anyone born in the house and anyone purchased with money from any foreigner who is not from your seed. (**Genesis 17:12**)
 - Every man born in your house and every man purchased with money of yours must without fail get circumcised, and my covenant in the flesh of **you** men must serve as a covenant to time indefinite. (**Genesis 17:13**)
 - And an uncircumcised male who **will** not get the flesh of his foreskin circumcised, **even** that soul must be cut off from his people. He **has** broken my covenant. (**Genesis 17:14**)
 - And God went on to **say** to Abraham; As for Sarai your wife, you must not call her name Sarai, because Sarah is her name. (**Genesis 17:15**)
 - And I **will** bless her and also give you a son from her, and I **will** bless her and she shall become nations, kings of peoples **will** come from her. (**Genesis 17:16**)
 - At this Abraham fell upon his face and began to laugh and to **say** in his heart; Will a man a hundred years old have a child born, and **will** Sarah, yes, **will** a woman ninety years old give birth? (**Genesis 17:17**)
 - Look! There are days coming, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I **will** conclude with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah a New Covenant. (**Jeremiah 31:31**)

- Not one like the covenant that I concluded with their forefathers in the day of my taking hold of their **hand** to bring them forth **out** of the land of Egypt, which covenant of mine they themselves broke, although I myself had husbandly ownership of them, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 31:32**)
- For this is the covenant that I shall conclude with the house of Israel after those days, is the utterance of Yehowah. I **will** put my Law within them, and in their heart I shall write it. And I **will** become their God, and they themselves **will** become my people. (**Jeremiah 31:33**)
- And they **will** no more teach each one his companion and each one his brother, saying; **Know** Yehowah! For they **will** all of them know me, from the least one of them **even** to the greatest one of them, is the utterance of Yehowah. For I shall forgive their error, and their sin I shall remember no more. (**Jeremiah 31:34**)
- This is **what** Yehowah, the Giver of the sun for light by day, the statutes of the moon and the stars for light by night, the One stirring up the sea that its waves may become boisterous, the One whose name is Yehowah of armies, **has said**. (**Jeremiah 31:35**)
- This is **what** the **Sovereign Lord** Yehowah **has said**; For the reason that Edom **has** acted in taking vengeance upon the house of Judah and they kept doing wrong extensively and avenged themselves on them. (**Ezekiel 25:12**)
- And their houses **will** certainly be turned over to others for possession, the fields and the wives at the same time. For I shall **stretch** my **hand out against** the inhabitants of the land, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 6:12**)
- Therefore this is **what** the **Sovereign Lord** Yehowah **has said**; I **will** also **stretch out** my **hand against** Edom and cut off from it man and domestic animal, and I **will make** it a devastated place from Teman, **even** to Dedan. By the sword they **will** fall. (**Ezekiel 25:13**)
- Therefore here I **am**, I have stretched **out** my **hand against** you, and I **will** give you as something to plunder to the nations, and I **will** cut you off from the peoples and destroy you from the lands. I shall annihilate you, and you **will** have to know that I **am** Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 25:7**)

- **And Esau I have hated, and I finally made his mountains a desolated **waste** and his inheritance for the jackals of the wilderness. (**Malachi 1:3**)**
