

Ezekiel 36:18 **And I proceeded to pour out my rage upon them on account of the blood that they had poured out upon the land, which land they had made unclean with their dungy idols.**

[9] - References:

- Do **you** not know that **you** people are God's temple, and that the spirit of God dwells in **you**? (**1 Corinthians 3:16**)
- If anyone destroys the temple of God, God will destroy him, for the temple of God is holy, which temple **you** people are. (**1 Corinthians 3:17**)
- He is set in opposition and lifts himself up over everyone who is called god or an object of reverence, so that he sits down in the temple of The God, publicly showing himself to be a god. (**2 Thessalonians 2:4**)
- And I went on to say to them; Throw away, each one of **you**, the disgusting things of his eyes, and with the **dungy idols** of Egypt do not defile yourselves. I am Yehowah **YOUR** God. (**Ezekiel 20:7**)
- Moreover, no one puts new wine into old wineskins, but if he does, then the new wine will burst the wineskins, and it will be spilled **out** and the wineskins will be ruined. (**Luke 5:37**)
- But new wine must be put into new wineskins. (**Luke 5:38**)
- No one that has drunk old wine wants new, for he says; The old is nice. (**Luke 5:39**)
- Go, inquire of Yehowah in my own behalf and in behalf of what is left in Israel and in Judah concerning the words of the book that has been found, for great is Yehowah's **rage** that must be **poured out** against us because of the fact that our forefathers did not keep the word of Yehowah by doing according to all that is written in this book. (**2 Chronicles 34:21**)
- So He kept pouring **out** upon him **rage**, his anger, and the strength of war. And it kept consuming him all around, but he took no note, and it kept blazing up against him, but he would lay nothing to heart. (**Isaiah 42:25**)
- For they have committed adultery and there is **blood** on their hands, and with their **dungy idols** they have committed adultery.

- And, besides that, their sons whom they had borne to me they **made** pass through the fire to them as food. (**Ezekiel 23:37**)
- Now shortly I shall **pour out** my **rage** upon you, and I will bring my anger against you to its finish, and I will judge you according to your ways and bring upon you all your detestable things. (**Ezekiel 7:8**)
 - Or were it pestilence that I should send upon that **land** and should I actually **pour out** my **rage** upon it with **blood**, in order to cut off from it earthling man and domestic animal. (**Ezekiel 14:19**)
