Ezekiel 36:19... And I proceeded to scatter them among the nations, so that they were dispersed among the lands. According to their way and according to their dealings I judged them.

- Therefore here I am bringing upon you strangers, the tyrants of the nations, and they will certainly draw their swords against the beauty of your wisdom and profane your beaming splendor. (Ezekiel 28:7)
- Can those already taken be taken from a mighty man himself, or can the body of captives of the tyrant make their escape? (Isaiah 49:24)
- But this is what Yehowah has said; Even the body of captives of the mighty man will be taken away, and those already taken by the tyrant himself will make their escape. And against anyone contending against you I myself shall contend, and your own sons I myself shall save. (Isaiah 49:25)
- For the day of Yehowah against all the nations is near. In the way that you have done, it will be done to you. Your sort of treatment will return upon your own head. (Obadiah 1:15)
- And you must perish among the nations, and the land of your enemies must eat you up. (Leviticus 26:38)
- And Yehowah will certainly scatter you among all the peoples from the one end of the earth to the other end of the earth, and there you will have to serve other gods whom you have not known, neither you nor your forefathers, wood and stone.

  (Deuteronomy 28:64)
- And I will scatter you among the nations and disperse you among the lands, and I will destroy your uncleanness out of you. (Ezekiel 22:15)
- Now the end is upon you, and I must send my anger against you, and I will judge you according to your ways and bring upon you all your detestable things. (Ezekiel 7:3)
- Therefore each one according to his ways is how I shall judge YOU, O house of Israel, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. Turn back, yes, cause a turning back from all YOUR

- transgressions, and let nothing prove to be for you people a stumbling block causing error. (Ezekiel 18:30)
- According to their uncleanness and according to their transgressions I did with them, and I kept concealing my face from them. (Ezekiel 39:24)
