

Ezekiel 36:23¹

And I shall certainly sanctify¹ my great name, which was being profaned among the nations, which you profaned in the midst of them, and the nations will have to know that I am Yehowah, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, when I am sanctified among you before their eyes.

- **By the rivers of Babylon, there we sat down. We also wept when we remembered Zion. (Psalms 137:1)**
- **Upon the poplar trees in the midst of her we hung our harps. (Psalms 137:2)**
- **For there those holding us captive asked us for the words of a song, and those mocking us, for rejoicing; SING for us one of the songs of Zion. (Psalms 137:3)**
- **How can we sing the song of Yehowah upon foreign ground? (Psalms 137:4)**
- **And it will certainly occur in that day that those remaining over of Israel and those who have escaped of the house of Jacob will never again support themselves upon the one striking them, and they will certainly support themselves upon Yehowah, the Holy One of Israel, in trueness. (Isaiah 10:20)**
- **A mere remnant will return, the remnant of Jacob, to the Mighty God. (Isaiah 10:21)**
- **For although your people, O Israel, would prove to be like the grains of sand of the sea, a mere remnant among them will return. An extermination decided upon will be flooding through in righteousness. (Isaiah 10:22)**
- **Because an exterminating and a strict decision the Sovereign Lord, Yehowah of armies, will be executing in the midst of the whole land. (Isaiah 10:23)**
- **And I shall certainly make her that was limping a remnant, and her that was removed far off a mighty nation, and Yehowah will actually rule as king over them in Mount Zion, from now on and into time indefinite. (Micah 4:7)**

- And he is changing times and seasons, removing kings and setting up kings, giving wisdom to the wise ones and knowledge to those knowing discernment. (**Daniel 2:21**)
- By the decree of watchers the thing is, and by the saying of holy ones the request is, to the intent that people living may **know** that the Most High is Ruler in the kingdom of mankind and that to the one whom he wants to, he gives it and he sets up over it even the lowliest one of mankind. (**Daniel 4:17**)
- Give in, **you** people, and **know** that I **am** God. I **will** be exalted **among** the **nations**, I **will** be exalted in the earth. (**Psalms 46:10**)
- And Yehowah of armies **will** become high through judgment, and the true God, the Holy One, **will** certainly **sanctify** himself through righteousness. (**Isaiah 5:16**)
- Because of the restful odor I shall take pleasure in **you**, when I bring **you** forth from the peoples and I actually collect **you** together from the lands to which **you have** been scattered, and I **will** be **sanctified** in **you before** the **eyes** of the nations. (**Ezekiel 20:41**)
- And the **nations will** fear the **name** of Yehowah, and all the kings of the earth your glory. (**Psalms 102:15**)
- And you must say; This is what the **Sovereign Lord** Yehowah has said; Here I **am** against you, O Sidon, and I shall certainly be glorified in the **midst** of you, and people **will have to know** that I **am** Yehowah when I execute acts of judgment in her and I **am** actually **sanctified** in her. (**Ezekiel 28:22**)
- To the end that all the peoples of the earth may **know** that Yehowah is the true God. There is no other. (**1 Kings 8:60**)
- And it came about at the time that the grain offering goes up that Elijah the prophet began to approach and say; O Yehowah, the God of Abraham, Isaac and Israel, today let it be known that you are God in Israel and I **am** your servant and it is by your word that I **have** done all these things. (**1 Kings 18:36**)
- How long, O God, **will** the adversary keep reproaching? Will the enemy keep treating your **name** with disrespect forever? (**Psalms 74:10**)

- Why should the **nations** say; Where is their God? Among the **nations** let there be known **before** our **eyes** the avenging of the blood of your servants that has been shed. (**Psalms 79:10**)
- A **name** is better than good oil, and the day of death than the day of one's **being** born. (**Ecclesiastes 7:1**)
- Just as when a beast itself goes down into the valley plain, the very spirit of Yehowah proceeded to make them rest. Thus you led your people in order to make a beautiful **name** for your own self. (**Isaiah 63:14**)
- As when a fire ignites the brushwood, and the fire makes the very water boil up, in order to make your **name** known to your adversaries, that on account of you the **nations** might be agitated! (**Isaiah 64:2**)
- And **you** people **will have** to **know** that I **am** Yehowah, when I bring **you** onto the soil of Israel, into the land that I lifted up my hand in an oath to give to **YOUR** forefathers. (**Ezekiel 20:42**)
- And the **nations will have** to **know** that I, Yehowah, **am** sanctifying Israel when my sanctuary comes to be in the **midst** of them to time indefinite. (**Ezekiel 37:28**)
- And you **will** be bound to come up against my people Israel, like clouds to cover the land. In the final part of the days it **will** occur, and I shall certainly bring you against my land, for the purpose that the **nations** may **know** me when I **sanctify** myself in you **before** their **eyes**, O Gog. (**Ezekiel 38:16**)
- And I shall certainly magnify myself and **sanctify** myself and make myself known **before** the **eyes** of many **nations**, and they **will have** to **know** that I **am** Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 38:23**)
- And I **will** set my glory **among** the **nations**, and all the **nations will have** to see my judgment that I **have** executed and my hand that I **have** placed **among** them. (**Ezekiel 39:21**)
- When I bring them back from the peoples and I actually collect them together out of the lands of their enemies, I **will** also **sanctify** myself **among** them **before** the **eyes** of many nations. (**Ezekiel 39:27**)
- **You** must pray, then, this way; Our Father in the heavens, let your **name** be **sanctified**. (**Matthew 6:9**)

- **Then he said to them; Whenever **you** pray, say, Father, let your **name** be **sanctified**. Let your kingdom come. (**Luke 11:2**)**
