

Ezekiel 36:26 And I will give **you** a new heart, and a new spirit I shall put inside **you**, and I will take away the heart of stone from **your** flesh and give **you** a heart of flesh.

- And Yehowah your God **will** have to circumcise your **heart** and the **heart** of your offspring, that you may love Yehowah your God with all your **heart** and all your soul for the sake of your life. (**Deuteronomy 30:6**)
- Look! There are days coming, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I **will** conclude with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah a **New Covenant**. (**Jeremiah 31:31**)
- Not one like the covenant that I concluded with their forefathers in the day of my taking hold of their hand to bring them forth out of the land of Egypt, which covenant of mine they themselves broke, although I myself had husbandly ownership of them, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 31:32**)
- For this is the covenant that I shall conclude with the house of Israel after those days, is the utterance of Yehowah. I **will** put my Law within them, and in their **heart** I shall write it. And I **will** become their God, and they themselves **will** become my people. (**Jeremiah 31:33**)
- And they **will** no more teach each one his companion and each one his brother, saying; **Know** Yehowah! For they **will** all of them know me, from the least one of them even to the greatest one of them, is the utterance of Yehowah. For I shall forgive their error, and their sin I shall remember no more. (**Jeremiah 31:34**)
- This is what Yehowah, the Giver of the sun for light by day, the statutes of the moon and the stars for light by night, the One stirring up the sea that its waves may become boisterous, the One whose name is Yehowah of armies, has said. (**Jeremiah 31:35**)
- And I **will** give them one **heart** and one way in order to fear me always, for good to them and to their sons after them. (**Jeremiah 32:39**)

- And I shall certainly bring **you** forth out of the midst of her and **give you** into the hand of strangers and execute upon **you** acts of judgment. (**Ezekiel 11:9**)
- Create in me even a pure **heart**, O God, and **put** within me a **new spirit**, a steadfast one. (**Psalms 51:10**)
- And their **heart** they set as an emery **stone** to keep from obeying the Law and the words that Yehowah of armies sent by his **spirit**, by means of the former prophets, so that there occurred great indignation on the part of Yehowah of armies. (**Zechariah 7:12**)
- For **you** are shown to be a letter of Christ written by us as ministers, inscribed not with ink but with **spirit** of a living God, not on **stone** tablets, but on fleshly tablets, on **hearts**. (**2 Corinthians 3:3**)
- Now as soon as he had finished speaking with him on Mount Sinai he proceeded to **give** Moses two tablets of the Testimony, tablets of **stone** written on by God's finger. (**Exodus 31:18**)
- Then Yehowah said to Moses; Carve out for yourself two tablets of **stone** like the first ones, and I must write upon the tablets the words that appeared on the first tablets, which you shattered. (**Exodus 34:1**)
- And I **will give** them one **heart** and one way in order to fear me always, for good to them and to their sons after them. (**Jeremiah 32:39**)
- And I **will give** them one **heart**, and a **new spirit** I shall **put inside** them, and I shall certainly remove the **heart of stone** from their **flesh** and **give** them a **heart of flesh**. (**Ezekiel 11:19**)
- Create in me even a pure **heart**, O God, and **put** within me a **new spirit**, a steadfast one. (**Psalms 51:10**)
- May loving-kindness and trueness themselves not leave you. Tie them about your throat. Write them upon the tablet of your **heart**. (**Proverbs 3:3**)
