

**Ezekiel 36:31** And **you** will be bound to remember **your** bad ways and **your** dealings that were not good, and **you** will be bound to feel a loathing at **your** own person on account of **your** errors and on account of **your** detestable things.

- However, there also came to be false prophets among the people, as there **will** also be false teachers among **you**. These very ones **will** quietly bring in destructive sects and **will** disown even the owner that bought them, bringing speedy destruction upon themselves. (**2 Peter 2:1**)
- Do **you** not know that **you** people are God's temple, and that the spirit of God dwells in **you**? (**1 Corinthians 3:16**)
- If anyone destroys the temple of God, God **will** destroy him, for the temple of God is holy, which temple **you** people are. (**1 Corinthians 3:17**)
- But let the one bragging about himself brag about himself because of this very thing, the having of insight and the having of knowledge of me, that I am Yehowah, the One exercising loving-kindness, justice and righteousness in the earth, for in these **things** I do take delight, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 9:24**)
- And **your** altars must be made desolate and **your** incense stands must be broken, and I **will** cause **your** slain ones to fall before **your** dungy idols. (**Ezekiel 6:4**)
- As for those remaining among **you**, they **will** rot away because of their error in the lands of **your** enemies. Yes, even because of the **errors** of their fathers, with them they **will** rot away. (**Leviticus 26:39**)
- And I went on to say; O my God, I do **feel** ashamed and embarrassed to raise my face to you, O my God, for our **errors** themselves have multiplied over our head and our guiltiness has grown great even to the heavens. (**Ezra 9:6**)
- However, they became disobedient and rebelled against you and kept casting your Law behind their back, and your **own** prophets they killed, who bore witness against them to bring them back to

you, and they went on committing acts of great disrespect.  
(**Nehemiah 9:26**)

- I have positively heard Ephraim bemoaning himself, You have corrected me, that I may be corrected, like a calf that has not been trained. Cause me to turn back, and I shall readily turn back, for you are Yehowah my God. (**Jeremiah 31:18**)
- And **YOUR** escaped ones **will** certainly **remember** me among the nations to which they **will** have been taken captive, because I have been broken up at their fornicating heart that has turned aside from me and at their eyes that are going in fornication after their dungy idols, and they **will** certainly **feel** a **loathing** in their faces at the **bad things** that they have done in all their **detestable things**. (**Ezekiel 6:9**)
- And **YOU will** certainly **remember** there **YOUR ways** and all **YOUR dealings** by which **YOU** defiled yourselves, and **YOU will** actually **feel** a **loathing** at **YOUR own** faces because of all **YOUR bad things** that **YOU** did. (**Ezekiel 20:43**)
- And I **will** pour out upon the house of David and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem the spirit of favor and entreaties, and they **will** certainly look to the One whom they pierced through, and they **will** certainly wail over Him as in the wailing over an only son, and there **will** be a bitter lamentation over him as when there is bitter lamentation over the firstborn son. (**Zechariah 12:10**)
- And they **will** certainly confess their **own** error and the error of their fathers in their unfaithfulness when they behaved unfaithfully toward me, yes, even when they walked in opposition to me. (**Leviticus 26:40**)
- We lie down in our shame, and our humiliation keeps covering us, for it is toward Yehowah our God that we have sinned, we and our fathers from our youth on and down to this day, and we have not obeyed the voice of Yehowah our God. (**Jeremiah 3:25**)
- And I **will** give them one heart, and a new spirit I shall put inside them, and I shall certainly remove the heart of stone from their flesh and give them a heart of flesh. (**Ezekiel 11:19**)
- In order that you may **remember** and actually be ashamed and you may no more come to have any reason to open your mouth because of your humiliation, when I make an atonement for you

**for all that you have done, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 16:63)**
