Sovereign Lord Yehowah, let it be known to you. Be ashamed and feel humiliation because of your ways, O house of Israel.

- Therefore say to the house of Israel; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Not for YOUR sakes am I doing it, O house of Israel, but for my holy name, which YOU have profaned among the nations where YOU have come in. (Ezekiel 36:22)
- No lion will prove to be there, and the rapacious sort of wild beasts will not come up on it. None will be found there, and the repurchased ones must walk there. (Isaiah 35:9)
- And the very ones redeemed by Yehowah will return and certainly come to Zion with a joyful cry, and rejoicing to time indefinite will be upon their head. To exultation and rejoicing they will attain, and grief and sighing must flee away. (Isaiah 35:10)
- Joyfully cry out, You heavens, for Yehowah has taken action! Shout in triumph, all You lowest parts of the earth! Become cheerful, You mountains, with joyful outcry, you forest and all You trees in it! For Yehowah has repurchased Jacob, and on Israel he shows his beauty. (Isaiah 44:23)
- For this is what Yehowah has said; It was for nothing that you people were sold, and it will be without money that you will be repurchased. (Isaiah 52:3)
- And now, what interest do I have here? Is the utterance of Yehowah. For my people were taken for nothing. The very ones ruling over them kept howling, is the utterance of Yehowah, and constantly, all day long, my name was being treated with disrespect. (Isaiah 52:5)
- For that reason my people will know my name, even for that reason in that day, because I am the One that is speaking. Look! It is I. (Isaiah 52:6)
- It is not for your righteousness or for the uprightness of your heart that you are going in to take possession of their land, in fact, it is for the wickedness of these nations that Yehowah your God is driving them away from before you, and in order to carry

- out the word that Yehowah swore to your forefathers, Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. (Deuteronomy 9:5)
- O Yehowah, do hear. O Yehowah, do forgive. O Yehowah, do pay attention and act. Do not delay, for your own sake, O my God, for your own name has been called upon your city and upon your people. (Daniel 9:19)
- What, then, was the fruit that you used to have at that time? Things of which you are now ashamed. For the end of those things is death. (Romans 6:21)
- Even it someone will bring to Assyria itself as a gift to a great king. Shame is what Ephraim himself will get, and Israel will be ashamed of its counsel. (Hosea 10:6)
