- And the nations **will have to know** that I, Yehowah, am sanctifying Israel when my sanctuary comes to be in the midst of them to time indefinite. (**Ezekiel 37:28**)
- God is not a man that he should tell lies, neither a son of mankind that he should feel regret. Has he himself said it and **will** he not do it, and **has** he **spoken** and **will** he not carry it out? (**Numbers 23:19**)
- Will your heart keep enduring or your hands furnish strength in the days when I am taking action toward you? I myself, Yehowah, **have spoken** and I **will** take action. (**Ezekiel 22:14**)
- And they **will** actually dwell upon it in security and build houses and plant vineyards, and they must dwell in security when I execute acts of judgment upon all those treating them with scorn all **round about** them, and they **will have to know** that I am Yehowah their God. (**Ezekiel 28:26**)
- And I **will** put my spirit in **you**, and **you** must come to life, and I **will** settle **you** upon **your** soil, and **you will have to know** that I myself, Yehowah, **have spoken** and I **have** done it, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 37:14**)
