And you yourselves, O mountains of Israel, will give forth your very own boughs and bear your own fruitage for my people Israel, for they have drawn near to the point of coming in.

[7] - References:

- Make the place of your tent more spacious. And let them stretch out the tent cloths of your grand tabernacle. Do not hold back.
  Lengthen out your tent cords, and make those tent pins of yours strong. (Isaiah 54:2)
- For to the right and to the left you will break forth, and your own offspring will take possession even of nations, and they will inhabit even the desolated cities. (Isaiah 54:3)
- Do not be afraid, for you will not be put to shame, and do not feel humiliated, for you will not be disappointed. For you will forget even the shame of your time of youth, and the reproach of your continuous widowhood you will remember no more. (Isaiah 54:4)
- For your Grand Maker is your husbandly owner, Yehowah of armies being his name, and the Holy One of Israel is your Repurchaser. The God of the whole earth he will be called. (Isaiah 54:5)
- For Yehowah called you as if you were a wife left entirely and hurt in spirit, and as a wife of the time of youth who was then rejected, your God has said. (Isaiah 54:6)
- For a little moment I left you entirely, but with great mercies I shall collect you together. (Isaiah 54:7)
- With a flood of indignation I concealed my face from you for but a moment, but with loving-kindness to time indefinite I will have mercy upon you, your Repurchaser, Yehowah, has said. (Isaiah 54:8)
- Let the rivers themselves clap their hands, all together let the very mountains cry out joyfully (Psalms 98:8)
- Joyfully cry out, You heavens, for Yehowah has taken action! Shout in triumph, all You lowest parts of the earth! Become cheerful, You mountains, with joyful outcry, you forest and all You

- trees in it! For Yehowah has repurchased Jacob, and on Israel he shows his beauty. (Isaiah 44:23)
- For Yehowah will certainly comfort Zion. He will for certain comfort all her devastated places, and he will make her wilderness like Eden and her desert plain like the garden of Yehowah. Exultation and rejoicing themselves will be found in her, thanksgiving and the voice of melody. (Isaiah 51:3)
- At that time you will see and certainly become radiant, and your heart will actually quiver and expand, because to you the wealthiness of the sea will direct itself, the very resources of the nations will come to you. (Isaiah 60:5)
- And I shall certainly make the fruitage of the tree abound, and the produce of the field, in order that you may no more receive among the nations the reproach of famine. (Ezekiel 36:30)
- And many peoples will certainly go and say; Come, You people, and let us go up to the mountain of Yehowah, to the house of the God of Jacob, and he will instruct us about his ways, and we will walk in his paths. For out of Zion Law will go forth, and the word of Yehowah out of Jerusalem. (Isaiah 2:3)
