

Ezekiel 37:21 And speak to them; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am taking the sons of Israel from among the nations to which they have gone, and I will collect them together from round about and bring them onto their soil.

[15] - References:

- The doorkeeper opens to this one, and the sheep listen to his voice, and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. (**John 10:3**)
- And I **have** other sheep, which are not of this fold, those also I must **bring**, and they **will** listen to my voice, and they **will** become one flock, one shepherd. (**John 10:16**)
- With that I heard a loud voice from the throne say; Look! The tent of God is with mankind, and he **will** reside with them, and they **will** be his peoples. And God himself **will** be with them. (**Revelation 21:3**)
- And he **will** wipe out every tear from their eyes, and death **will** be no more, neither **will** mourning nor outcry nor pain be anymore. The former things **have** passed away. (**Revelation 21:4**)
- And he showed me a river of water of life, clear as crystal, flowing out from the throne of God and of the Lamb. (**Revelation 22:1**)
- Down the middle of its broad way. And on this side of the river and on that side there were trees of life producing twelve crops of fruit, yielding their fruits each month. And the leaves of the trees were for the curing of the **nations**. (**Revelation 22:2**)
- And no more **will** there be any curse. But the throne of God and of the Lamb **will** be in the city, and his slaves **will** render him sacred service. (**Revelation 22:3**)
- And they **will** see his face, and his name **will** be on their foreheads. (**Revelation 22:4**)
- Also, night **will** be no more, and they **have** no need of lamplight nor do they **have** sunlight, because Yehowah God **will** shed light upon them, and they **will** rule as kings forever and ever. (**Revelation 22:5**)

- Yehowah your God must also **bring** back your captives and show you mercy and **collect** you again from all the peoples where Yehowah your God **has** scattered you. (**Deuteronomy 30:3**)
- And he **will** certainly raise up a signal for the **nations** and gather the dispersed ones of **Israel**, and the scattered ones of Judah he **will collect together** from the four extremities of the earth. (**Isaiah 11:12**)
- As Yehowah is alive who brought the **sons** of **Israel** up out of the land of the north and out of all the lands to which he had dispersed them! and I shall certainly **bring** them back to their **soil**, which I gave to their forefathers. (**Jeremiah 16:15**)
- And I myself shall **collect together** the remnant of my sheep out of all the lands to which I had dispersed them, and I **will bring** them back to their pasture ground, and they **will** certainly be fruitful and become many. (**Jeremiah 23:3**)
- And I **will** gather back the captive ones of my people **Israel**, and they **will** actually build the desolated cities and inhabit them, and plant vineyards and drink the wine of them, and make gardens and eat the fruit of them. (**Amos 9:14**)
- Yehowah is building Jerusalem, the dispersed ones of **Israel** he **brings together**. (**Psalms 147:2**)
- And it **will** certainly occur in that day that those remaining over of **Israel** and those who **have** escaped of the house of Jacob **will** never again support themselves upon the one striking them, and they **will** certainly support themselves upon Yehowah, the Holy One of **Israel**, in trueness. (**Isaiah 10:20**)
- Here I **am** collecting them **together** out of all the lands to which I shall **have** dispersed them in my anger and in my rage and in great indignation, and I **will bring** them back to this place and make them dwell in security. (**Jeremiah 32:37**)
- And I **will** take **you** out of the **nations** and **collect you together** out of all the lands and **bring you** in upon **YOUR soil**. (**Ezekiel 36:24**)
- Like a bird they **will** come trembling out of Egypt, and like a dove out of the land of Assyria, and I shall certainly make them dwell in their houses, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Hosea 11:11**)

- **In that day, is the utterance of Yehowah, I will gather her that was limping, and her that was dispersed I will collect together, even her whom I have treated badly. (Micah 4:6)**
