- This one **will** be great and **will** be called Son of the Most High, and Yehowah God **will** give him the throne of **David** his father. (**Luke 1:32**)
- And he **will** rule as **king** over the house of Jacob forever, and there **will** be no end of his kingdom. (**Luke 1:33**)
- Look! There are days coming, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I **will** raise up to **David** a righteous sprout. And a **king will certainly** reign and act with discretion and execute justice and righteousness in the land. (**Jeremiah 23:5**)
- And they **will certainly** serve Yehowah their God and **David** their **king**, whom I shall raise up for them. (**Jeremiah 30:9**)
- Afterwards the sons of Israel **will come** back and **certainly** look for Yehowah their God, and for **David** their **king**, and they **will certainly come** quivering to Yehowah and to his goodness in the final part of the days. (**Hosea 3:5**)
- This one **will** be great and **will** be called Son of the Most High, and Yehowah God **will** give him the throne of **David** his father. (**Luke 1:32**)
- And I **have** other sheep, which are not of this fold, those also I must bring, and they **will** listen to my voice, and they **will** become one flock, one **shepherd**. (**John 10:16**)
- And when the chief **shepherd** has been made manifest, **you will** receive the unfadable crown of glory. (**1 Peter 5:4**)
- He **will** cause the meek ones to **walk** in his **judicial** decision, and he **will** teach the meek ones his way. (**Psalms 25:9**)
- For you **will** listen to the voice of Yehowah your God so as to **keep** his commandments and his **statutes** written in this book of the Law, because you **will** return to Yehowah your God with all your heart and all your soul. (**Deuteronomy 30:10**)

- And I **will** give them one heart and one way in order to fear me always, for good to them and to their sons after them. (**Jeremiah 32:39**)
- And my spirit I shall put inside **you**, and I **will** act so that in my regulations **you will walk**, and my **judicial decisions you will keep** and actually **carry out**. (**Ezekiel 36:27**)
- And I shall **certainly** defend this city to save it for my own sake and for the sake of **David** my servant. (**Isaiah 37:35**)
- And I **will** raise up over them one **shepherd**, and he must feed them, even my servant **David**. He himself **will** feed them, and he himself **will** become their **shepherd**. (**Ezekiel 34:23**)
- In that day I shall raise up the booth of **David** that is fallen, and I shall **certainly** repair their breaches. And its ruins I shall raise up, and I shall **certainly** build it up as in the days of long ago. (**Amos 9:11**)
- And he **will certainly** stand and do shepherding in the strength of Yehowah, in the superiority of the name of Yehowah his God. And they **will certainly keep** dwelling, for now he **will** be great as far as the ends of the earth. (**Micah 5:4**)
