- Incline **YOUR** ear and **come** to me. Listen, and **YOUR** soul **will** keep alive, and I shall readily **conclude** with **you** people an **indefinitely lasting covenant** respecting the loving-kindnesses to David that are faithful. (**Isaiah 55:3**)
- And I **will conclude** with them an **indefinitely lasting covenant**, that I shall not turn back from behind them, for me to do them good, and the fear of me I shall put in their heart in order not to turn aside from me. (**Jeremiah 32:40**)
- And from them there **will** certainly go forth thanksgiving, and the sound of those who are laughing. And I **will multiply** them, and they **will** not become few, and I **will** make them heavy in number, and they **will** not become insignificant. (**Jeremiah 30:19**)
- And the public squares of the city themselves **will** be filled with boys and girls playing in her public squares. (**Zechariah 8:5**)
- Saying; Assuredly in blessing I **will** bless you, and in multiplying I **will multiply** you. (**Hebrews 6:14**)
- And I shall certainly put my tabernacle in the **midst** of **you**, and my soul **will** not abhor **you**. (**Leviticus 26:11**)



- And **what** agreement does God's temple have with idols? For we are a temple of a living God, just as God said; I shall reside among them and walk among them, and I shall be their God, and they **will** be my people. (**2 Corinthians 6:16**)
