Ezekiel 39:11" And it must occur in that day that I shall give to Gog a place there, a burial place in Israel, the valley of those passing through on the east of the sea, and it will be stopping up those passing through. And there they will have to bury Gog and his entire crowd, and they will be certain to call it the Valley of Gog's Crowd.

- And if ever your hand makes you stumble, cut it off, it is finer for you to enter into life maimed than with two hands to go off into Gehenna, into the fire that cannot be put out. (Mark 9:43)
