

Ezekiel 39:25 **Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Now is when I shall bring back the captive ones of Jacob and actually have mercy upon all the house of Israel, and I will show exclusive devotion for my holy name.**

- **And I saw a great white throne and the one seated on it. From before him the earth and the heaven fled away, and no place was found for them. ([Revelation 20:11](#))**
- **And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and scrolls were opened. But another scroll was opened, it is the scroll of life. And the dead were judged out of those things written in the scrolls according to their deeds. ([Revelation 20:12](#))**
- **And the sea gave up those dead in it, and death and Hades gave up those dead in them, and they were judged individually according to their deeds. ([Revelation 20:13](#))**
- **But now they are reaching out for a better place, that is, one belonging to heaven. Hence God is not ashamed of them, to be called upon as their God, for he **has** made a city ready for them. ([Hebrews 11:16](#))**
- **Women received their dead by resurrection, but other men were tortured because they would not accept release by some ransom, in order that they might attain a better resurrection. ([Hebrews 11:35](#))**
- **For, look! There are days coming, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I **will** gather the **captive ones** of my people, **Israel** and Judah, Yehowah **has said**, and I **will bring** them **back** to the land that I gave to their forefathers, and they **will** certainly repossess it. ([Jeremiah 30:3](#))**
- **And I **will bring** them out from the peoples and collect them together from the lands and **bring** them in onto their soil and feed them on the mountains of **Israel**, by the streambeds and by all the dwelling places of the land. ([Ezekiel 34:13](#))**
- **At that time, is the utterance of Yehowah, I shall become God to all the families of **Israel**, and as for them, they **will** become my people. ([Jeremiah 31:1](#))**

- And the sons of Judah and the sons of **Israel will** certainly be collected together into a unity and **will actually** set up for themselves one head and go up out of the land, because great **will** be the day of Jezreel. (**Hosea 1:11**)
- Therefore this is what Yehowah **has said**; I shall certainly return to Jerusalem with mercies. My own **house will** be built in her, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies, and a measuring line itself **will** be stretched out over Jerusalem. (**Zechariah 1:16**)
- For you must not prostrate yourself to another god, because Yehowah, whose **name** is Jealous, he is a jealous God. (**Exodus 34:14**)
- And I shall **have** compassion on my **holy name**, which the **house of Israel have** profaned among the nations where they **have** come in. (**Ezekiel 36:21**)
- You **have** taken pleasure, O Yehowah, in your land, you **have** brought **back** the **ones** taken **captive** of **Jacob**. (**Psalms 85:1**)
- In the coming days **Jacob will** take root, **Israel will** put forth blossoms and **actually** sprout, and they **will** simply fill the surface of the productive land with produce. (**Isaiah 27:6**)
- And my anger **will** certainly come to its finish and I **will** appease my rage on them and comfort myself, and they **will have** to know that I myself, Yehowah, **have** spoken in my insistence on **exclusive devotion**, when I **bring** my rage to its finish upon them. (**Ezekiel 5:13**)
- And the slain one **will** certainly fall in the midst of **you**, and **you will have** to know that I am Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 6:7**)
- And I **will** gather **back** the **captive ones** of my people **Israel**, and they **will actually** build the desolated cities and inhabit them, and plant vineyards and drink the wine of them, and make gardens and eat the fruit of them. (**Amos 9:14**)
- And it must become a region for the remaining **ones** of the **house** of Judah. Upon them they **will** feed. In the **houses** of Ashkelon, in the evening, they **will** lie stretched out. For Yehowah their God **will** turn his attention to them and certainly gather **back** the **captive ones** of them. (**Zephaniah 2:7**)

- At that time I shall **bring you** people in, even in the time of my collecting **you** together. For I shall make **you** people to be a **name** and a praise among all the peoples of the earth, when I gather **back your captive ones** before **your** eyes, Yehowah **has said**.
