

**Ezekiel 39:26<sup>••</sup> And they will have borne their humiliation and all their unfaithfulness with which they have acted toward me, when they dwell on their soil in security, with no one to make them tremble.**

- With that I heard a loud voice from the throne say; Look! The tent of God is with mankind, and he will reside with them, and they will be his peoples. And God himself will be with them. **(Revelation 21:3)**
- And he will wipe out every tear from their eyes, and death will be no more, neither will mourning nor outcry nor pain be anymore. The former things **have** passed away. **(Revelation 21:4)**
- And he showed me a river of water of life, clear as crystal, flowing out from the throne of God and of the Lamb. **(Revelation 22:1)**
- Down the middle of its broad way. And on this side of the river and on that side there were trees of life producing twelve crops of fruit, yielding their fruits each month. And the leaves of the trees were for the curing of the nations. **(Revelation 22:2)**
- And no more will there be any curse. But the throne of God and of the Lamb will be in the city, and his slaves will render him sacred service. **(Revelation 22:3)**
- And they will see his face, and his name will be on their foreheads. **(Revelation 22:4)**
- Also, night will be no more, and they **have** no need of lamplight nor do they **have** sunlight, because Yehowah God will shed light upon them, and they will rule as kings forever and ever. **(Revelation 22:5)**
- And the nations will walk by means of its light, and the kings of the earth will bring their glory into it. **(Revelation 21:24)**
- And its gates will not be closed at all by day, for night will not exist there. **(Revelation 21:25)**
- And they will bring the glory and the honor of the nations into it. **(Revelation 21:26)**

- And just a little while longer, and the wicked one will be no more, and you will certainly give attention to his place, and he will not be. (**Psalms 37:10**)
- But the meek ones themselves will possess the earth, and they will indeed find their exquisite delight in the abundance of peace. (**Psalms 37:11**)
- The righteous themselves will possess the earth, and they will reside forever upon it. (**Psalms 37:29**)
- In his days the righteous one will sprout, and the abundance of peace until the moon is no more. (**Psalms 72:7**)
- And he will **have** subjects from sea to sea and from the River to the ends of the earth. (**Psalms 72:8**)
- As for the one listening to me, he will reside in **security** and be undisturbed from dread of calamity. (**Proverbs 1:33**)
- O Yehowah, according to all your acts of righteousness, please, may your anger and your rage turn back from your city Jerusalem, your holy mountain, for, because of our sins and because of the errors of our forefathers, Jerusalem and your people are an object of reproach to all those round about us. (**Daniel 9:16**)
- O Yehowah our God, you yourself answered them. A God granting pardon you proved to be to them, and executing vengeance against their notorious deeds. (**Psalms 99:8**)
- And **YOUR** threshing will certainly reach to **YOUR** grape gathering, and the grape gathering will reach to the sowing of seed, and **YOU** will indeed eat **YOUR** bread to satisfaction and  **dwell** in **security** in **YOUR** land. (**Leviticus 26:5**)
- In his days Judah will be saved, and Israel itself will reside in **security**. And this is his name with which he will be called, **Yehowah Is Our Righteousness**. (**Jeremiah 23:6**)
- And they will actually sit, each one under his vine and under his fig tree, and there will be no one making them **tremble**, for the very mouth of Yehowah of armies has spoken it. (**Micah 4:4**)
- As regards the remaining ones of Israel, they will do no unrighteousness, nor speak a lie, nor will there be found in their

**mouths a tricky tongue, for they themselves will feed and actually lie stretched out, and there will be no one making them tremble. (Zephaniah 3:13)**
