

**Ezekiel 39:28** And they will have to know that I am Yehowah their God, when I send them in exile to the nations and actually bring them together upon their soil, so that I shall leave none of them remaining there any longer.

- And I will raise up over them shepherds who will **actually** shepherd them, and they will be afraid no more, neither will they be struck with any terror, and **none** will be missing, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 23:4**)
- And they will **have** to **know** that I, Yehowah their **God**, **am** with them and that they are my people, the house of Israel, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 34:30**)
- If your dispersed people should be at the end of the heavens, from there Yehowah your **God** will collect you and from there he will take you. (**Deuteronomy 30:4**)
- In order that people may see and **know** and pay heed and **have** insight at the same time, that the very hand of Yehowah has done this, and the Holy One of Israel has himself created it. (**Isaiah 41:20**)
- And I will make those maltreating you eat their own flesh, and as with the sweet wine they will become drunk with their own blood. And all flesh will **have** to **know** that I, Yehowah, **am** your Savior and your Repurchaser, the Powerful One of Jacob. (**Isaiah 49:26**)
- And I will let myself be found by **you**, is the utterance of Yehowah. And I will gather **your** body of captives and collect **you together** out of all the **nations** and out of all the places to which I **have** dispersed **you**, is the utterance of Yehowah. And I will **bring you** back to the place from which I caused **you** to go into **exile**. (**Jeremiah 29:14**)
- For, look! In those days and in that time, when I shall **bring** back the captive ones of Judah and Jerusalem. (**Joel 3:1**)
