Ezekiel 39:28... And they will have to know that I am Yehowah their God, when I send them in exile to the nations and actually bring them together upon their soil, so that I shall leave none of them remaining there any longer.

- And I will raise up over them shepherds who will actually shepherd them, and they will be afraid no more, neither will they be struck with any terror, and none will be missing, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 23:4)
- And they will have to know that I, Yehowah their God, am with them and that they are my people, the house of Israel, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 34:30)
- If your dispersed people should be at the end of the heavens, from there Yehowah your God will collect you and from there he will take you. (Deuteronomy 30:4)
- In order that people may see and know and pay heed and have insight at the same time, that the very hand of Yehowah has done this, and the Holy One of Israel has himself created it. (Isaiah 41:20)
- And I will make those maltreating you eat their own flesh, and as with the sweet wine they will become drunk with their own blood. And all flesh will have to know that I, Yehowah, am your Savior and your Repurchaser, the Powerful One of Jacob. (Isaiah 49:26)
- Yehowah. And I will gather Your body of captives and collect You together out of all the nations and out of all the places to which I have dispersed You, is the utterance of Yehowah. And I will bring You back to the place from which I caused You to go into exile. (Jeremiah 29:14)
- For, look! In those days and in that time, when I shall bring back the captive ones of Judah and Jerusalem. (Joel 3:1)
