- But Jesus, calling them to him, said; **You know** that the rulers of the **nations** lord it over them and the great men wield authority over them. (**Matthew 20:25**)
- This is not the way among **you**, but whoever wants to become great among **you** must be **your** minister. (**Matthew 20:26**)
- And whoever wants to be first among **you** must be **your** slave. (**Matthew 20:27**)
- Just as the Son of man came, not to be ministered to, but to minister and to give his soul a ransom in exchange for many. (**Matthew 20:28**)
- Let every soul be in subjection to the superior authorities, for there is no authority except by God, the existing authorities stand placed in their relative positions by God. (**Romans 13:1**)
- And you must not allow the devoting of any of your offspring to Molech. You must not profane the **name** of your God that way. I **am** Yehowah. (**Leviticus 18:21**)
- And I went acting for the sake of my own **name** that it might not be **profaned** before the eyes of the **nations** in among whom they were, because I had made myself **known** to them before their eyes on bringing them forth from the land of Egypt. (**Ezekiel 20:9**)
- And you **will** be bound to come up against my **people Israel**, like clouds to cover the land. In the final part of the days it **will** occur, and I shall certainly bring you against my land, for the purpose that the **nations** may **know** me when I sanctify myself in you before their eyes, O Gog. (**Ezekiel 38:16**)

- And this one called to that one and said; Holy, **holy, holy** is Yehowah of armies. The fullness of all the earth is his glory. (**Isaiah 6:3**)
- To the end that all the **peoples** of the earth may **know** that Yehowah is the true God. There is no other. (**1 Kings 8:60**)
- Then the man of the true God approached and said to the king of **Israel**, yes, he went on to say; This is what Yehowah has said, For the reason that the Syrians **have** said; Yehowah is a God of mountains, and he is not a God of low plains, I shall **have** to give all this great crowd into your hand, and **you** men **will** certainly **know** that I **am** Yehowah. (**1 Kings 20:28**)
- By means of your servants you **have** taunted Yehowah and you say; with the multitude of my war chariots I myself; I shall certainly ascend the height of mountainous regions, the remotest parts of Lebanon, and I shall cut down its lofty cedars, its choice juniper trees. And I shall enter its final height, the forest of its orchard. (**Isaiah 37:24**)
- And He went on to say to me; Son of man, this is the place of my throne and the place of the soles of my feet, where I shall reside in the **midst** of the sons of **Israel** to time indefinite, and no more **will** they, the house of **Israel**, defile my **holy name**, they and their kings, by their fornication and by the carcasses of their kings at their death. (**Ezekiel 43:7**)
