

Ezekiel 3:11 **And go, enter in among the exiled people, among the sons of your people, and you must speak to them and say to them; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said, regardless of whether they hear or they refrain.**

[6] - References:

- And when they have finished their witnessing, the wild beast that ascends out of the abyss will make war with them and conquer them and kill them. (**Revelation 11:7**)
- And their corpses will be on the broad way of the great city which is in a spiritual sense called Sodom and Egypt, where their **Lord** was also impaled. (**Revelation 11:8**)
- And those of the **peoples** and tribes and tongues and nations will look at their corpses for three and a half days, and they do not let their corpses be laid in a tomb. (**Revelation 11:9**)
- And those dwelling on the earth rejoice over them and enjoy themselves, and they will send gifts to one another, because these two prophets tormented those dwelling on the earth. (**Revelation 11:10**)
- And he went on to **say**; Go, and you **must say** to this **people**, Hear again and again, O men, but do not understand, and see again and again, but do not get any knowledge. (**Isaiah 6:9**)
- Make the heart of this **people** unreceptive, and make their very ears unresponsive, and paste their very eyes together, that they may not see with their eyes and with their ears they may not **hear**, and that their own heart may not understand and that they may not actually turn back and get healing for themselves. (**Isaiah 6:10**)
- And he took into exile all Jerusalem and all the princes and all the valiant, mighty men, ten thousand he was taking into exile, and also every craftsman and builder of bulwarks. No one had been left behind except the lowly class of the **people** of the land. (**2 Kings 24:14**)
- And as for them, whether they will **hear** or will **refrain**, for they are a rebellious house, they will certainly know also that a prophet himself happened to be in the midst of them. (**Ezekiel 2:5**)

- Hence I call **you** to witness this very day that I am clean from the blood of all men. (**Acts of Apostles 20:26**)
- Son of man, **speak** to the **sons** of your **people**, and you **must say** to them, As regards a land, in case I bring upon it a sword and the **people** of the land, one and all, actually take a man and set him as their watchman. (**Ezekiel 33:2**)
