And a spirit¹ proceeded to bear me along and I began to hear behind me the sound of a great rushing; Blessed be the glory of Yehowah from his place.

- And he proceeded to say; It has been more than a trivial matter for you to become my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob and to bring back even the safeguarded ones of Israel, I also have given you for a light of the nations, that my salvation may come to be to the extremity of the earth. - Then he thrust out the representation of a hand and took me by a tuft of hair of my head, and a spirit carried me between the earth and the heavens and brought me to Jerusalem in the visions of God, to the entrance of the inner gate that is facing northward, where the dwelling place is of the symbol of jealousy that is inciting to jealousy. (Ezekiel 8:3)
- When they had come up out of the water, Yehowah's spirit quickly led Philip away, and the eunuch did not see him anymore, for he kept going on his way rejoicing. (Acts of Apostles 8:39)

- And suddenly there occurred from heaven a noise just like that of a rushing stiff breeze, and it filled the whole house in which they were sitting. (Acts of Apostles 2:2)
- And the cherubs now lifted up their wings, and the wheels were close by them, and the glory of the God of Israel was over them, from above. (Ezekiel 11:22)
