**But as for you, in case you have warned someone wicked and he does not actually turn back from his wickedness and from his wicked way, he himself for his error will die, but as for you, you will have delivered your own soul.<sup>1</sup>**

[13] - References:

- Look! All the **souls**, to me they belong. As the **soul** of the father so likewise the **soul** of the son, to me they belong. The **soul** that is sinning, it itself **will die**. (**Ezekiel 18:4**)
- And Yehowah kept warning Israel and Judah by means of all his prophets and every visionary, saying; Turn **back** from **YOUR** bad **ways** and keep my commandments, my statutes, according to all the Law that I commanded **YOUR** forefathers and that I **have** sent to **YOU** by means of my servants the prophets. (**2 Kings 17:13**)
- And he **will** render to each one according to his works. (**Romans 2:6**)
- But as for me, I said; It is for nothing that I **have** toiled. For unreality and vanity I **have** used up my **own** power. Truly my judgment is with Yehowah, and my wages with my God. (**Isaiah 49:4**)
- But as for you, you keep seeking great things for yourself. Do not keep on seeking. For here I am bringing in a calamity upon all flesh, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I **will** give you your **soul** as a spoil in all the places to which you may go. (**Jeremiah 45:5**)
- But as regards you, in case you **actually** warn **someone wicked** from his **way** for him to **turn back** from it but he **actually** does not **turn back** from his **way**, he himself **will die** in his **own error**, whereas you yourself **will** certainly deliver your **own soul**. (**Ezekiel 33:9**)
- But after they kept on opposing and speaking abusively, he shook out his garments and said to them; Let **YOUR** blood be upon **YOUR own** heads. I am clean. From now on I **will** go to people of the nations. (**Acts of Apostles 18:6**)

- Hence I call **you** to witness this very day that I am clean from the blood of all men. (**Acts of Apostles 20:26**)
- But now return the man's wife, for he is a prophet, and he **will** make supplication for you. So keep living. But if you are not returning her, know that you **will** positively **die**, you and all who are yours. (**Genesis 20:7**)
- To this Solomon said; If he **will** become a valiant man, there **will** not fall a single hair of his to the earth, but if what is bad should be found in him, he **will** also **have** to die. (**1 Kings 1:52**)
- And now here Yehowah has put a deceptive spirit in the mouth of these prophets of yours, but Yehowah himself has spoken calamity concerning you. (**2 Chronicles 18:22**)
- And the hearer **actually** hears the sound of the horn but he takes no warning at all, and a sword comes and takes him away, his **own** blood **will** come to be upon his **own** head. (**Ezekiel 33:4**)
- If anyone's work is burned up, he **will** suffer loss, but he himself **will** be saved, yet, if so, it **will** be as through fire. (**1 Corinthians 3:15**)
