And the hand of Yehowah came to be upon me there and he proceeded to say to me; Get up, go forth to the valley plain, and there I shall speak with you.

- Therefore get out from among them, and separate yourselves, says Yehowah, and quit touching the unclean thing, and I will take you in. (2 Corinthians 6:17)
- Come up close, You nations, to hear, and You national groups, pay attention. Let the earth and that which fills it listen, the productive land and all its produce. (Isaiah 34:1)
- For Yehowah has indignation against all the nations, and rage against all their army. He must devote them to destruction, he must give them to the slaughter. (Isaiah 34:2)
- And their slain ones will be thrown out, and as for their carcasses, their stink will ascend, and the mountains must melt because of their blood. (Isaiah 34:3)
- And all those of the army of the heavens must rot away. And the heavens must be rolled up, just like a book scroll, and their army will all shrivel away, just as the leafage shrivels off the vine and like a shriveled fig off the fig tree. (Isaiah 34:4)
- And you must say; O mountains of Israel, hear the word of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said to the mountains and to the hills, to the streambeds and to the valleys; Here I am! I am bringing upon you a sword, and I shall certainly destroy your high places. (Ezekiel 6:3)
- And the high places of Beth-aven, the sin of Israel, will actually be annihilated. Thorns and thistles themselves will come up upon their altars. And people will in fact say to the mountains; Cover us! And to the hills; Fall over us! (Hosea 10:8)
- And, look! The glory of the God of Israel was there, like the appearance that I had seen in the valley plain. (Ezekiel 8:4)
- And it came about in the sixth year, in the sixth month, on the fifth day of the month, that I was sitting in my house and the

older men of Judah were sitting before me, when the hand of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah fell upon me there. (Ezekiel 8:1)
