Ezekiel 3:26... And your very tongue I will make stick to the roof of your mouth, and you will certainly become mute, and you will not become to them a man<sup>1</sup> administering reproof, because they are a rebellious house.

- He was hard pressed, and he was letting himself be afflicted, yet he would not open his mouth. He was being brought just like a sheep to the slaughtering, and like a ewe that before her shearers has become mute, he also would not open his mouth. (Isaiah 53:7)
- Let my tongue stick to my palate, if I were not to remember you, if I were not to make Jerusalem ascend above my chief cause for rejoicing. (Psalms 137:6)
- In that day your mouth will be opened to the escaped one, and you will speak and be mute no longer, and you will certainly become to them a portent, and they will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 24:27)
- But when he came out he was not able to speak to them, and they perceived that he had just seen a supernatural sight in the sanctuary, and he kept making signs to them, but remained dumb. (Luke 1:22)
- In the gate they have hated a reprover, and a speaker of perfect things they detest. (Amos 5:10)
- Hear, O heavens, and give ear, O earth, for Yehowah himself has spoken; Sons I have brought up and raised, but they themselves have revolted against me. (Isaiah 1:2)
- And you, O son of man, do not be afraid of them, and of their words do not be afraid, because there are obstinate ones and things pricking you and it is among scorpions that you are dwelling. Of their words do not you be afraid, and at their faces do not you be struck with terror, for they are a rebellious house. (Ezekiel 2:6)
- Son of man, in the midst of a rebellious house is where you are dwelling, that have eyes to see but they actually do not see, that

have ears to hear but they actually do not hear, for they are a rebellious house. (Ezekiel 12:2)

- At length it occurred in the twelfth year, in the tenth month, on the fifth day of the month of our exile, that there came to me the escaped one from Jerusalem, saying; The city has been struck down! (Ezekiel 33:21)
- But, look! You will be silent and not able to speak until the day that these things take place, because you did not believe my words, which will be fulfilled in their appointed time. (Luke 1:20)
