And when I speak with you I shall open your mouth, and you must say to them, This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said. Let the one hearing hear, and let the one refraining refrain, because they are a rebellious house.

[11] - References:

- Look! The hand of Yehowah has not become too short that it cannot save, nor has his ear become too heavy that it cannot hear. (Isaiah 59:1)
- No, but the very errors of You people have become the things causing division between You and Your God, and Your own sins have caused the concealing of his face from You to keep from hearing. (Isaiah 59:2)
- In that day your mouth will be opened to the escaped one, and you will speak and be mute no longer, and you will certainly become to them a portent, and they will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 24:27)
- Now the very hand of Yehowah had come to be upon me in the evening before the coming of the escaped one, and He proceeded to open my mouth prior to that one's coming to me in the morning, and my mouth was opened and I proved to be speechless no longer. (Ezekiel 33:22)
- Let him that has ears listen. (Matthew 11:15)
- Let the one who has an ear hear what the spirit says to the congregations. (Revelation 2:29)
- For it is a rebellious people, untruthful sons, sons who have been unwilling to hear the Law of Yehowah. (Isaiah 30:9)
- But this very people has come to have a stubborn and rebellious heart, they have turned aside and keep walking in their course. (Jeremiah 5:23)
- Son of man, in the midst of a rebellious house is where you are dwelling, that have eyes to see but they actually do not see, that have ears to hear but they actually do not hear, for they are a rebellious house. (Ezekiel 12:2)

- O Yehowah, may you open these lips of mine, that my own mouth may tell forth your praise. (Psalms 51:15)
- And you must speak my words to them, regardless of whether they hear or they refrain, for they are a case of rebellion. (Ezekiel 2:7)
- In that day I shall cause a horn to sprout for the house of Israel, and to you I shall give occasion to open the mouth in the midst of them, and they will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 29:21)
