[6] - References:

- Here I am bringing in upon **you** men a nation from far away, O house of Israel, is the utterance of Yehowah. It is an enduring nation. It is a nation of long ago, a nation **whose language** you do not know, and you cannot **hear** understandingly what they speak. (**Jeremiah 5:15**)
- And the men of Nineveh began to put faith in God, and they proceeded to proclaim a fast and to put on sackcloth, from the greatest one of them even to the least one of them. (**Jonah 3:5**)
- Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! Because if the powerful works had taken place in Tyre and Sidon that took place in **you**, they would long ago have repented in sackcloth and ashes. (**Matthew 11:21**)
- Men of Nineveh will rise up in the judgment with this generation and will condemn it, because they repented at what Jonah preached, but, look! something more than Jonah is here. (**Matthew 12:41**)
- And so, talking with boldness, Paul and Barnabas said; It was necessary for the word of God to be spoken first to **you**. Since **you** are thrusting it away from **you** and do not judge yourselves worthy of everlasting life, look! We turn to the nations. (**Acts of Apostles 13:46**)
- Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! Because if the powerful works that have taken place in **you** had taken place in Tyre and Sidon, they would long ago have repented sitting in sackcloth and ashes. (**Luke 10:13**)
