- The one that conquers, I will make him a pillar in the temple of my God, and he will by no means go out from it anymore, and I will write upon him the name of my God and the name of the city of my God, the new Jerusalem which descends out of heaven from my God, and that new name of mine. (**Revelation 3:12**)
- And I saw another strong angel descending from heaven, arrayed with a cloud, and a rainbow was upon his head, and his face was as the sun, and his feet were as fiery pillars. (**Revelation 10:1**)
- But in case I am delayed, that you may know how you ought to conduct yourself in God's household, which is the congregation of the living God, a pillar and support of the truth. (**1 Timothy 3:15**)
- Yes, when they came to know the undeserved kindness that was given me, James and Cephas and John, the ones who seemed to be pillars, gave me and Barnabas the right hand of sharing together, that we should go to the nations, but they to those who are circumcised. (**Galatians 2:9**)
- True, not a one of the others had the courage to join himself to them, nevertheless, the people were extolling them. (**Acts of Apostles 5:13**)
- And said; We positively ordered **YOU** not to keep teaching upon the basis of this name, and yet, look! **YOU** have filled Jerusalem with **YOUR** teaching, and **YOU** are determined to bring the blood of this man upon us. (**Acts of Apostles 5:28**)
- In answer Peter and the other apostles said; We must obey God as ruler rather than men. (**Acts of Apostles 5:29**)
- And we are witnesses of these matters, and so is the Holy Spirit, which God has given to those obeying him as ruler. (**Acts of Apostles 5:32**)

- **At this they gave heed to him, and they summoned the apostles, flogged them, and ordered them to stop speaking upon the basis of Jesus' name, and let them go. (Acts of Apostles 5:40)**
- **These, therefore, went their way from before the Sanhedrin, rejoicing because they had been counted worthy to be dishonored in behalf of his name. (Acts of Apostles 5:41)**
- **And every day in the temple and from house to house they continued without letup teaching and declaring the Good News about the Christ, Jesus. (Acts of Apostles 5:42)**
- **Consequently the word of God went on growing, and the number of the disciples kept multiplying in Jerusalem very much, and a great crowd of priests began to be obedient to the faith. (Acts of Apostles 6:7)**
