And he gradually brought me into the outer courtyard, and, look! there were dining rooms, and a pavement made for the courtyard all around. There were thirty dining rooms upon the pavement.

- Now I do not want you to be ignorant, brothers, that our forefathers were all under the cloud and all passed through the sea. (1 Corinthians 10:1)
- And all got baptized into Moses by means of the cloud and of the sea. (1 Corinthians 10:2)
- And all ate the same spiritual food (1 Corinthians 10:3)
- And all drank the same spiritual drink. For they used to drink from the spiritual rock-mass that followed them, and that rockmass meant the Christ. (1 Corinthians 10:4)
- And he carved cherubs and palm-tree figures and engravings of blossoms, and overlaid gold foil upon the representations. (1 Kings 6:35)
- Even the architectural plan of everything that had come to be with him by inspiration for the courtyards of Yehowah's house and for all the dining rooms all around, for the treasures of the house of the true God and for the treasures of the things made holy. (1 Chronicles 28:12)
- There will be twenty-five thousand in length and ten thousand in width. It will become the Levites', the ministers of the house. As a possession they will have twenty dining rooms. (Ezekiel 45:5)
- But as for the courtyard that is outside the temple sanctuary, cast it clear out and do not measure it, because it has been given to the nations, and they will trample the holy city underfoot for forty-two months. (Revelation 11:2)
