- When the man went forth eastward with a measuring line in his hand, he also proceeded to measure a thousand in cubits and to make me pass through the water, water up to the ankles. (**Ezekiel 47:3**)
- And I proceeded to raise my eyes and see, and, look! There was a man, and in his hand a measuring rope. (**Zechariah 2:1**)
- And a reed like a rod was given me as he said; Get up and measure the temple sanctuary of God and the altar and those worshipping in it. (**Revelation 11:1**)

- Now the one who was speaking with me was holding as a measure a golden **reed**, that he might measure the city and its **gates** and its wall. (**Revelation 21:15**)
- And I began to hear someone speaking to me out of the House, and the **man** himself had come to be **standing** beside me. (**Ezekiel 43:6**)
- Therefore this is what Yehowah has said; I shall certainly return to Jerusalem with mercies. My own house will be built in her, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies, and a **measuring** line itself will be stretched out over Jerusalem. (**Zechariah 1:16**)
