And, look! There was a wall outside the house all round about. And in the hand of the man there was the measuring reed<sup>1</sup> of six cubits,<sup>2</sup> by a cubit and a handbreadth. And he began to measure the breadth of the thing built,<sup>3</sup> one reed, and the height, one reed.

- Wake up, wake up, put on your strength, O Zion! Put on your beautiful garments, O Jerusalem, the holy city! For no more will there come again into you the uncircumcised and unclean one. (Isaiah 52:1)
- But he that enters through the door is shepherd of the sheep. (John 10:2)
- You are already clean because of the word that I have spoken to You. (John 15:3)

- And these are the measurements of the altar in cubits, a cubit being a cubit and a handbreadth. And its bottom is a cubit. And a cubit is the width. And its border is upon its lip round about, one span. And this is the base of the altar. (Ezekiel 43:13)
- And a reed like a rod was given me as he said; Get up and measure the temple sanctuary of God and the altar and those worshiping in it. (Revelation 11:1)
- Now the one who was speaking with me was holding as a measure a golden reed, that he might measure the city and its gates and its wall. (Revelation 21:15)
