Ezekiel 40:6." Then he came to the gate, the front of which is toward the east, and went up by its steps. And he began to measure the threshold of the gate, one reed in width, and the other threshold, one reed in width.

And the guard chambers of the gate toward the east were three on this side and three on that side. The three of them were of the same measurement, and the side pillars were of the same measurement, on this side and on that side. (Ezekiel 40:10)

Then he made me go to the gate, the gate that is facing toward the east. (Ezekiel 43:1)

And the chieftain must come in by the way of the porch of the gate, from outside, and stand by the doorpost of the gate, and the priests must render up his whole burnt offering and his communion sacrifices, and he must bow down upon the threshold of the gate, and he must go out, but the gate itself should not be shut until the evening. (Ezekiel 46:2)

- And he finished the measurements of the inner house, and he brought me out by the way of the gate the front of which was toward the east, and he measured it all around. (Ezekiel 42:15)
