Ezekiel 41:11... And the entrance of the side chamber was to the space left open, one entrance being toward the north and one entrance to the south, and the width of the area of the space left open was five cubits, all around.

- Then I turned and went down from the mountain and placed the tablets in the ark that I had made, that they might continue there, just as Yehowah had commanded me. (Deuteronomy 10:5)
- Yehowah now spoke to Moses, saying; (Numbers 17:1)
- Speak to the sons of Israel and take from them one rod for each paternal house from all their chieftains, by the house of their fathers, twelve rods. You will write the name of each one upon his rod. (Numbers 17:2)
- And Aaron's name you will write upon Levi's rod, because there is one rod for the head of the house of their fathers. (Numbers 17:3)
- And you must deposit them in the tent of meeting before the Testimony, where I regularly present myself to YOU. (Numbers 17:4)
- And what must occur is that the man whom I shall choose, his rod will bud, and I shall certainly make subside from against me the murmurings of the sons of Israel, which they are murmuring against YOU. (Numbers 17:5)
- So Moses spoke to the sons of Israel, and all their chieftains went giving him a rod for each chieftain, a rod for each chieftain, by the house of their fathers, twelve rods, and Aaron's rod was in among their rods. (Numbers 17:6)
- Then Moses deposited the rods before Yehowah in the tent of the Testimony. (Numbers 17:7)
- And it came about the next day that when Moses went into the tent of the Testimony, look! Aaron's rod for the house of Levi had budded, and it was bringing forth buds and blossoming flowers and was bearing ripe almonds. (Numbers 17:8)

- Moses then brought out all the rods from before Yehowah to all the sons of Israel, and they went looking and taking each man his own rod. (Numbers 17:9)
- Subsequently Yehowah said to Moses; Put Aaron's rod back before the Testimony as something to be kept for a sign to the sons of rebelliousness, that their murmurings may cease from against me, that they may not die. (Numbers 17:10)
- So Moses said to Aaron; Take a jar and put in it an omerful of manna and deposit it before Yehowah as something to be kept throughout YOUR generations. (Exodus 16:33)
- Just as Yehowah had commanded Moses, Aaron proceeded to deposit it before the Testimony as something to be kept. (Exodus 16:34)
- The entrance of the lowest side chamber was on the right side of the house, and by a winding staircase they would go up to the middle one, and from the middle one up to the third one. (1 Kings 6:8)
