- And, look! There was a wall outside the house all round about. And in the hand of the man there was the measuring reed of six cubits, by a cubit and a handbreadth. And he began to measure the breadth of the thing built, one reed, and the height, one reed. (Ezekiel 40:5)
- From this there will prove to be for the holy place five hundred by five hundred, it being made square round about, and fifty cubits it will have as pasture ground on each side. (Ezekiel 45:2)
- Both in order to make a distinction between the holy thing and the profane and between the unclean thing and the clean. (Leviticus 10:10)
- Her priests themselves have done violence to my Law, and they keep profaning my holy places. Between the holy thing and the common they have made no distinction, and between the unclean thing and the clean they have made nothing known, and from my Sabbaths they have hidden their eyes, and I am profaned in the midst of them. (Ezekiel 22:26)
- And my people they should instruct in the difference between a holy thing and a profane thing, and the difference between what is unclean and what is clean they should cause them to know. (Ezekiel 44:23)
- Therefore get out from among them, and separate yourselves, says Yehowah, and quit touching the unclean thing, and I will take you in. (2 Corinthians 6:17)

- **But anything not sacred and anyone that carries on a disgusting thing and a lie will in no way enter into it, only those written in the Lamb's scroll of life will. (Revelation 21:27)**
