Ezekiel 43:1" Then he made me go to the gate, the gate that is facing toward the east.

- And the cherubs now lifted up their wings and rose from the earth before my eyes. When they went forth, the wheels also were close alongside them, and they began standing at the eastern entrance of the gate of the house of Yehowah, and the glory of the God of Israel was over them, from above. (Ezekiel 10:19)
- Then he came to the gate, the front of which is toward the east, and went up by its steps. And he began to measure the threshold of the gate, one reed in width, and the other threshold, one reed in width. (Ezekiel 40:6)
- And he finished the measurements of the inner house, and he brought me out by the way of the gate the front of which was toward the east, and he measured it all around. (Ezekiel 42:15)
- And he proceeded to bring me back by way of the gate of the sanctuary, the outer one facing east, and it was shut. (Ezekiel 44:1)
